RE: BCPO Payroll Memo #25-08, Maintenance Charges for Employees

Residing in Commonwealth Facilities - 2026

In June 2008, Executive Board Resolution (EBR) MC-08-086 was approved. It stipulates that maintenance charges will be increased each January for Commonwealth employees who are residing in Commonwealth facilities. The increase in maintenance charges is effective beginning the first full pay period in **January 2026**. The increase is based on the percentage change in Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) for the Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Delaware, and Maryland area for the most recent 12-month period for which figures have been officially reported by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics immediately prior to **January 1, 2026**.

Along with this memo, we are providing you with a copy of the 2026 schedule of maintenance charges. The schedule can also be referenced on the <u>Tax Information</u> page of our website. A list of employees who have maintenance charges as of December 18th was sent to applicable agency contacts. They are to review the list and verify the correct deduction amounts for maintenance charges.

Per Management Directive 315.14, employees living in Commonwealth facilities for personal convenience who are not required to do so by the responsibilities of their jobs are required to enter into leases through the Department of General Services (DGS).
