**SUMMARY:** This bill provides for fund transfers during the novel coronavirus as identified in the Governor's Proclamation of Disaster Emergency issued on March 6, 2020.

**ANALYSIS:** SB 1096 establishes any deposits made into the General Fund under 4 Pa.C.S. § 13A62(b)(3) relating to table game taxes shall cease and instead be deposited into the Small Business First Fund for small business economic injury relief during the novel coronavirus disaster proclamation.

If a licensee is not conducting business, the deposits shall first be made from the Budget Stabilization Reserve Fund.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Table game taxes are payable weekly based upon gross table game revenue derived during the previous week. During the first six months of Fiscal Year 2019-20, state tax revenue from table games totaled \$63.249 million for an average weekly deposit of \$2.423 million.
