**SUMMARY:** This bill amends the Pennsylvania Constitution to expand absentee voting.

**ANALYSIS:** SB 411 allows all qualified electors to vote through an absentee ballot. No law under this subsection may require electors to physically appear at a designated polling place on election day.

SB 411 would be the first passage of this language. Constitutional amendments must pass in two consecutive legislative sessions then be approved through referendum.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Constitutional amendments carry a cost of \$1.3 million to \$1.5 million in two consecutive legislative sessions to comply with the advertising requirements of Section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania.
