SUMMARY: This bill increases the pension amount of blind, amputee, and parlyzed veterans in Pennsylvania.

ANALYSIS: HB 1144 amends Title 51 (Military Affairs) to increase the Blind Veterans Pension and the Amputee and Paralyzed Veterans Pension for every eligible participant from the current \$150 to \$200 per month. The Adjutant General of the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs (DMVA) determines eligibility for the pensions.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT: The Blind Veterans Pension currently serves 98 veterans, and the Amputee and Paralyzed Veterans Pension serves 2,345 veterans for a total of 2,443 individuals served. DMVA predicts a 15% increase in participation, which would be approximately 2,809 participants. To increase pensions by \$50 for each eligible participant for 12 months, DMVA would need an additional \$1.741 million each year, approximately \$145,083 for each month the pension increase is in effect.
