

CREATIVE ENTREPRENEUR ACCELERATOR (CEA) PROGRAM

Overview

The Creative Entrepreneur Accelerator (CEA) Program is designed to:

- Pair creative entrepreneurs with existing small business consulting services.
- Help creative entrepreneurs grow their business, audience, and revenue.
- Provides access to the Impact Management System (IMS) / Business Growth Ladder (BGL) to track business growth and engagement over time.

The Process



Connect with creative entrepreneurs interested in starting or growing a business.



Creative entrepreneur reaches out to PPA Partner for referral coordinator information.



Creative entrepreneur & referral coordinator consult and review business plan.



Referral coordinator works with and refers creative entrepreneur to PPA regional partner.



Creative entrepreneur completes and submits client information form & application to PPA Partner.



Upon receipt of eligible and complete application, PPA Partner enters into grant award agreement with creative entrepreneur.



Entrepreneur self-reports business data into IMS/BGL System, at which point grant funds are dispersed.



A year after funds are received, Entrepreneur submits final report into IMS/BGL and submits proof of eligible purchases to PPA Partner.

Roles & Responsibilities

Pennsylvania Creative Industries

A state agency under the Office of the Governor with the mission to empower, connect and amplify creatives and creative industries and their contributions to Pennsylvania's communities, economy, and workforce.

Responsibilities:

- Program funder
- Act as a liaison between PPA Partners and referral coordinators
- Provide funding to the Creative
 Entrepreneur Accelerator Program

Pennsylvania Partners in the Arts (PPA)

Regional re-granting organization that assists Pennsylvania Creative Industries in allocating state arts funds to support local and community arts projects and programs.

Responsibilities:

- Accept the referral form provided by the referral coordinator
- Review the client information form provided by the creative entrepreneur for eligibility
- Provide the application form to the creative entrepreneur
- Review and accept the application
- Provide funding check to creative entrepreneur

Referral Coordinators

A local small business development organization (i.e. local Small Business Development Centers).

Responsibilities:

- Provide free consultation services and a business plan review for the creative entrepreneur
- Complete the referral form and submit it to the PPA Partner

Creative Entrepreneurs

Creative entrepreneurs must operate in the creative industry, be at least 18 years old, a current resident of PA for one year, and (if applicable) manage a business with gross revenue of less than \$200,000.

Responsibilities:

- Complete one consultation with a referral coordinator
- Complete and submit client information form to the PPA Partner
- Complete and submit application to the PPA Partner and self-report data into IMS/BGL
- If eligible and receive grant, submit all required IMS/BGL reporting and proof of eligible purchases.
