Poetry Out Loud is a national poetry recitation contest that helps high school students build confidence, public speaking skills, and a love for poetry. Students memorize and perform poems, progressing from school to state and national competitions.

What's New This Year?

- All poems must be selected from the Poetry Out Loud America 250 Online Anthology.
- Schools/Organizations may advance up to 2 students to a regional competition.
- Students may choose to compete at any of the virtual regional competitions.
- Each student competing at a regional competition must prepare 2 poems.
- The top 2 students from each regional competition will advance to the state competition.
