Erie CCC

1. Does the Erie CCC provide food for reentrants?

No. The Erie CCC does not provide food or meals for reentrants. Each reentrant must provide their own food and cooking utensils.

2. Are cell phones permitted?

Yes.

3. When will the reentrant be permitted to spend time with their family?

Starting on their first day, all reentrants will have utility time/periods of leave in line with their accomplishments, setbacks and curfew.

4. How many clothing items can a person have?

- 8 pairs of pants or shorts
- 8 shirts
- 3 pair of shoes
- 3 hats
- 2 coats

5. When are visiting hours?

Daily visiting hours are from 5 to 8 pm.

6. Can a reentrant have a television at the facility?

No

7. Can a reentrant work and if so what shifts?

Yes. Reentrants are always encouraged to work and may work first, second or third shift jobs.

8. How long must a reentrant wait before submitting a home plan?

Reentrants are encouraged to submit home plans as soon as the plan is available for residency.

9. When will a reentrant meet with a counselor at the facility?

Reentrants will meet with a counselor at the facility within their first 72 hours.

10. Will reentrants be required to pay rent?
