Map Overview

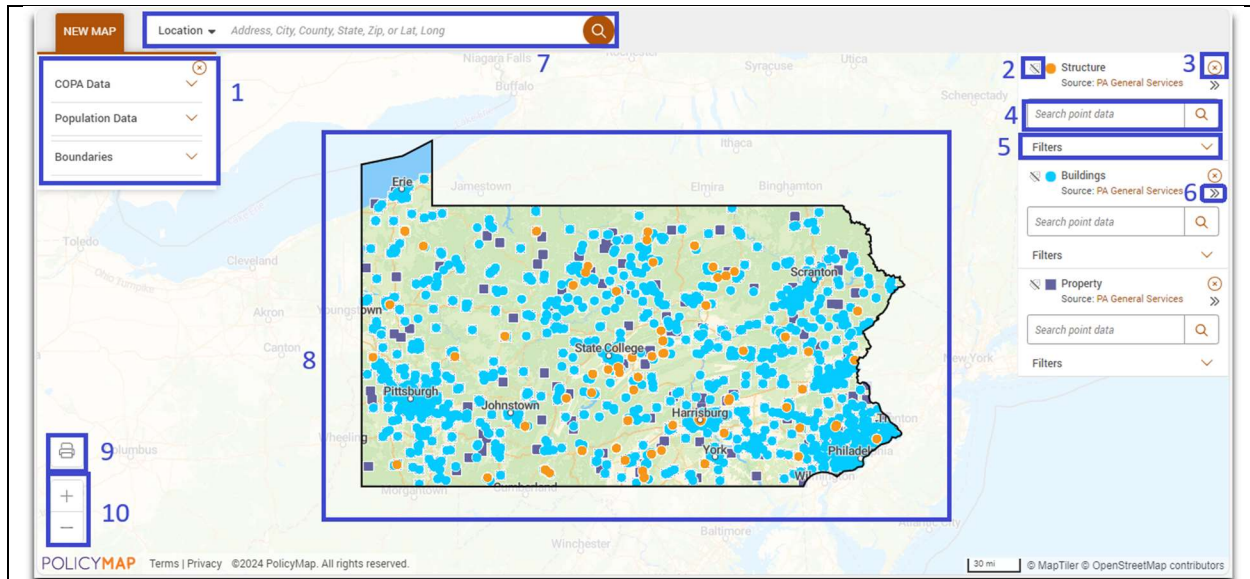


Image A

- 1: Add elements to the map by clicking on them in this list.
- 2: Turn on/off labels for this element are shown.
- 3: Remove element from the map. It can be re-added using 1.
- 4: Search for locations on the map.
- 5: Expand list for map filters (explained more below).
- 6: Collapse/expand this section.
- 7: Search for locations on the map.
- 8: Click and drag to pan the map screen. The mouse wheel can be used to zoom in and out. Click on points to see information about them.
- 9: Print the map screen.
- 10: Zoom the map screen in and out.

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Filters Menu

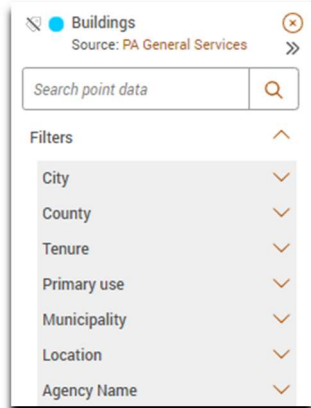

Image B:

The filter list contains multiple options for focusing your search. Each dropdown includes checkboxes for turning on and off each category filter. Selecting one changes the map to show only locations that match the chosen filter. More than one checkbox can be selected; it will show all selected categories. For example, if Harrisburg is selected from the city list, only buildings in Harrisburg will be shown. If Harrisburg and Philadelphia are both selected, buildings from both Harrisburg and Philadelphia will be shown.

Location Information

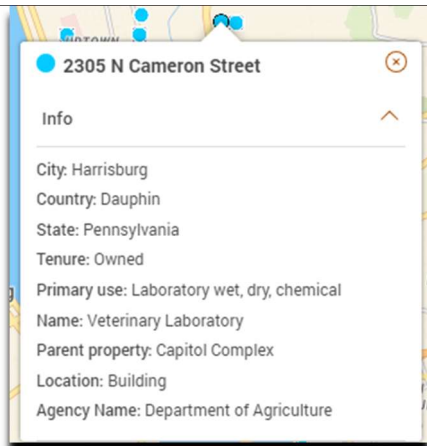

Clicking on any of the points of the map will open an info box as shown. It contains information on the location, use, and identity of the property.

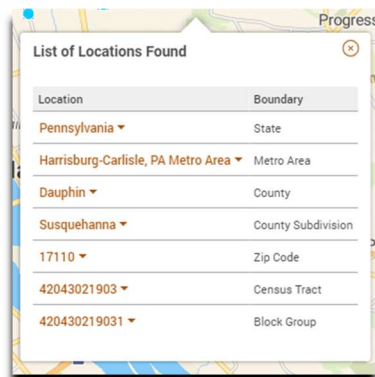


Image D

Clicking on a spot that doesn't have a marked point opens an info box like this one, which gives generic information about the area. The names on the left can then be clicked on to apply filters to the map.
