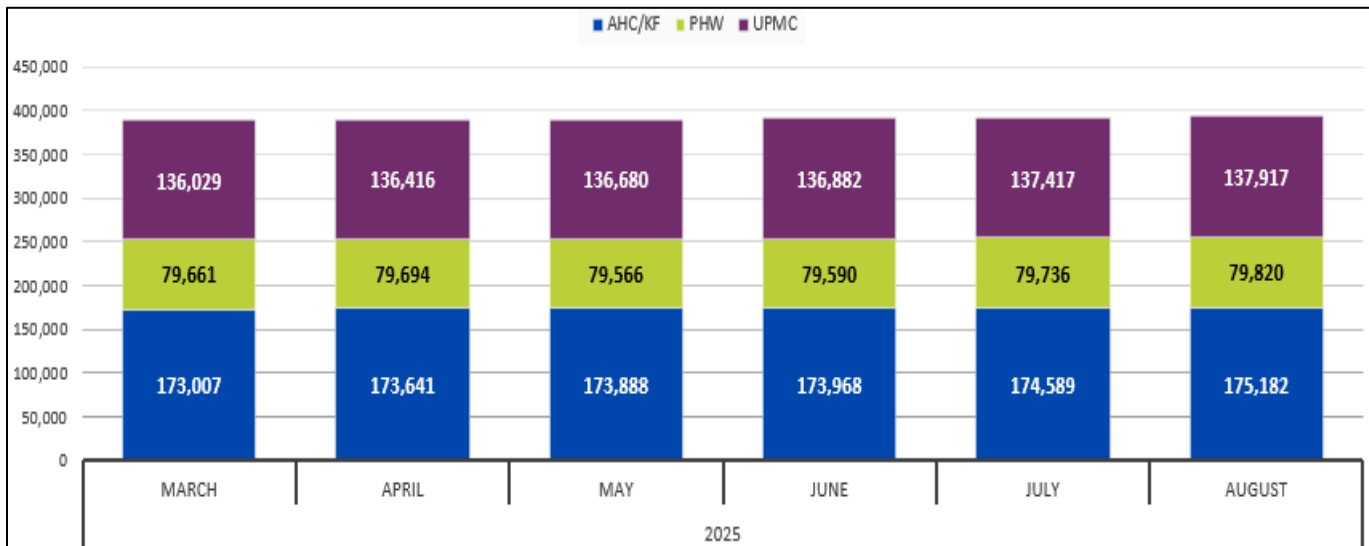

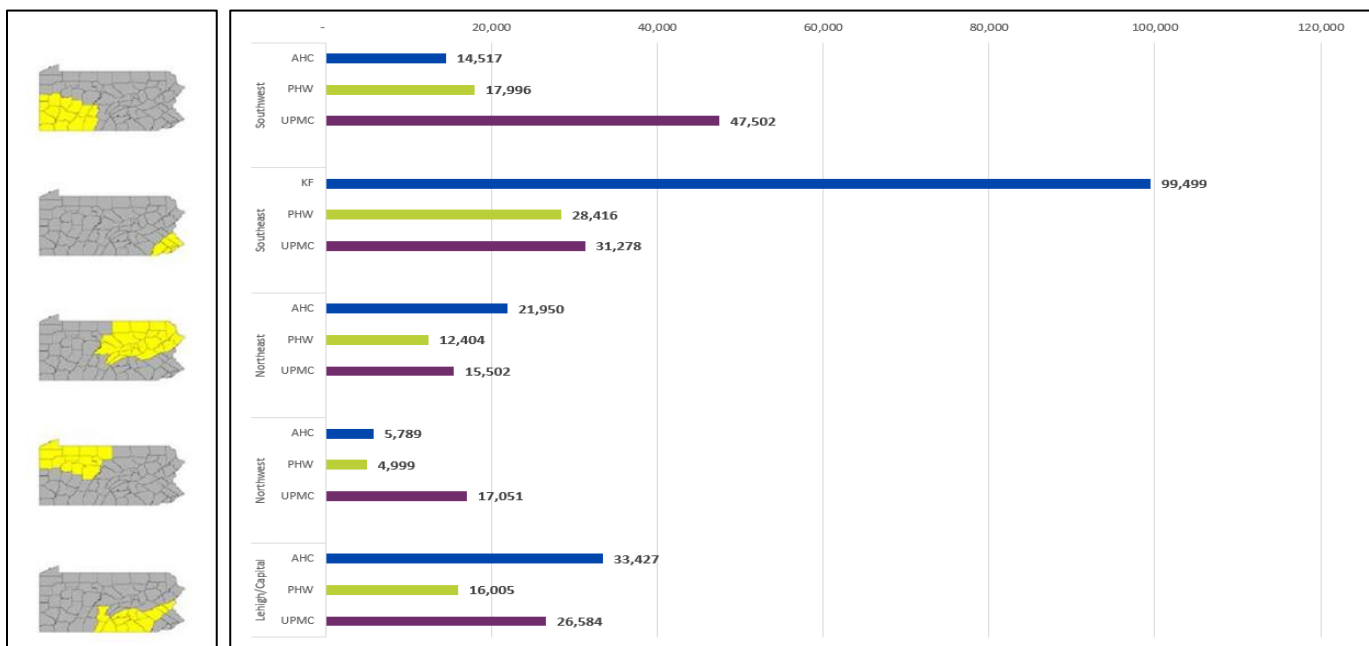

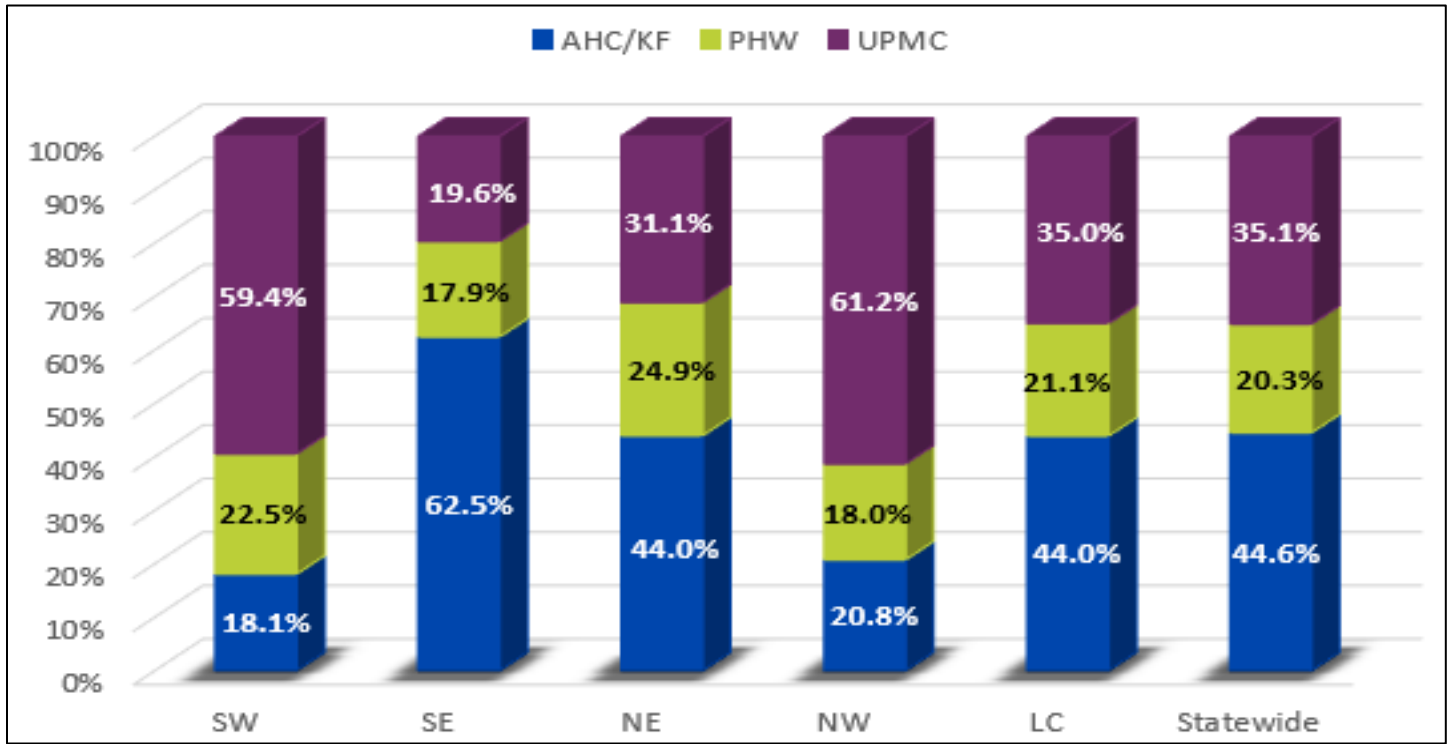

CHC Market Share Chart



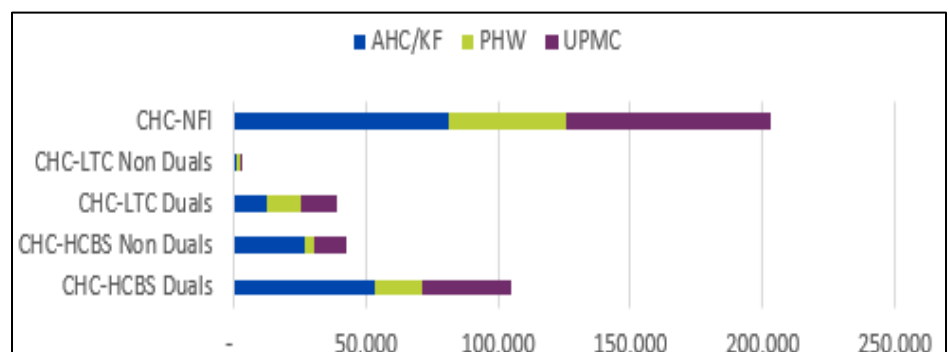

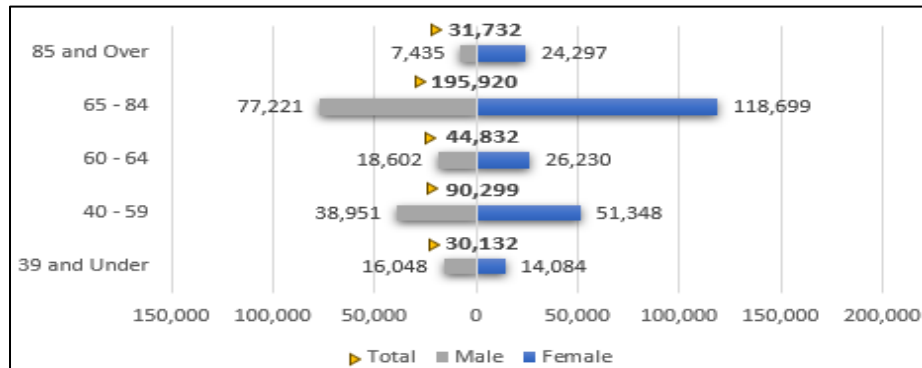

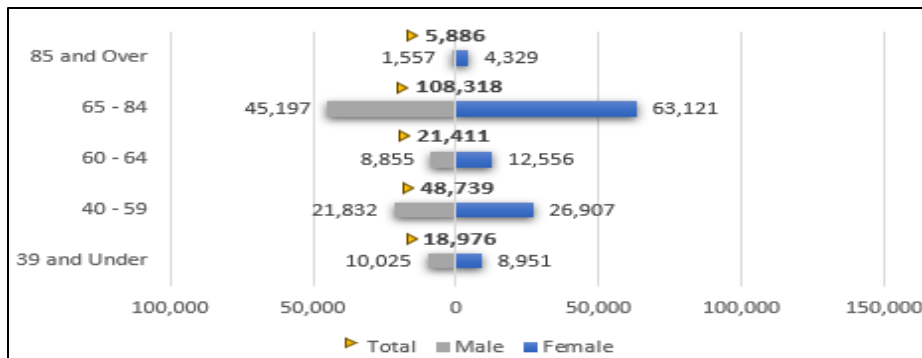


CHC Enrollments by Age, Gender, & Population Groups

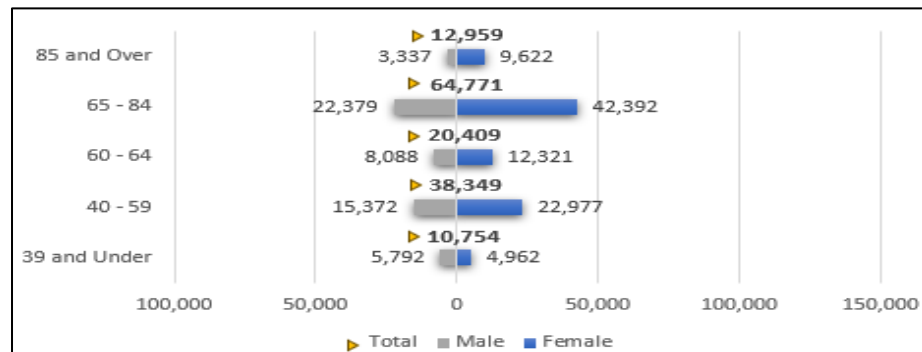
CHC by Gender and Age Group



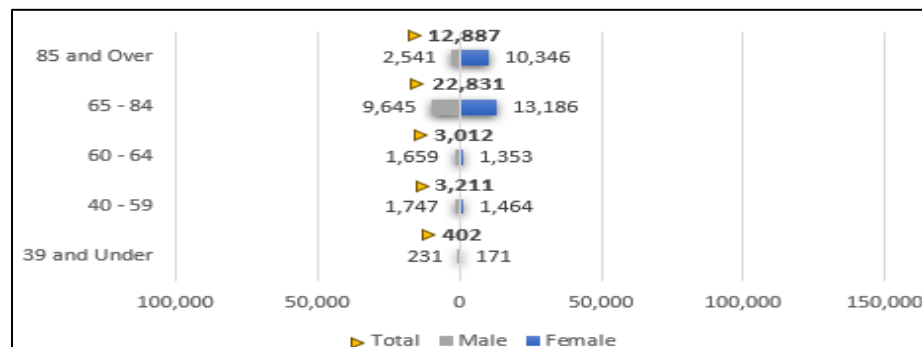
CHC-NFI by Gender and Age Group



CHC-HCBS by Gender and Age Group

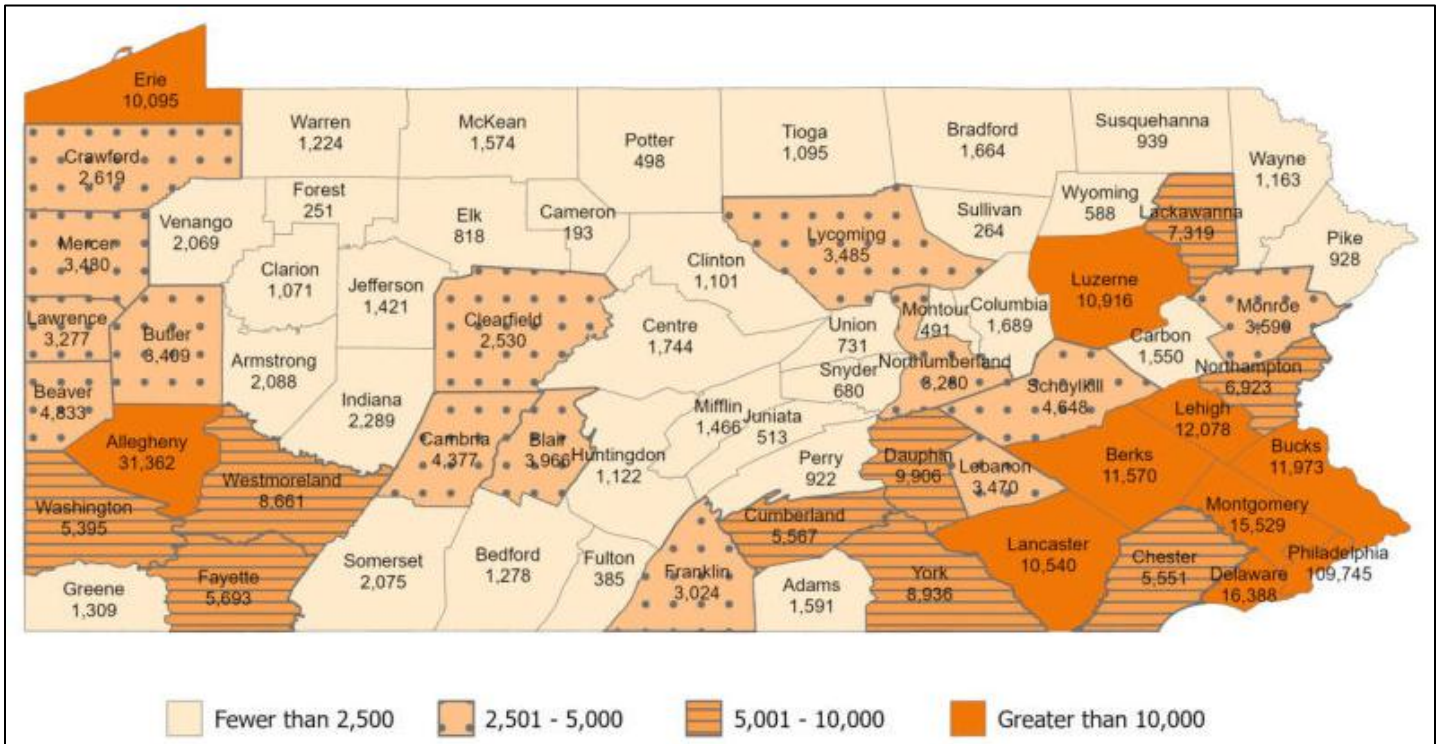


CHC-LTC by Gender and Age Group

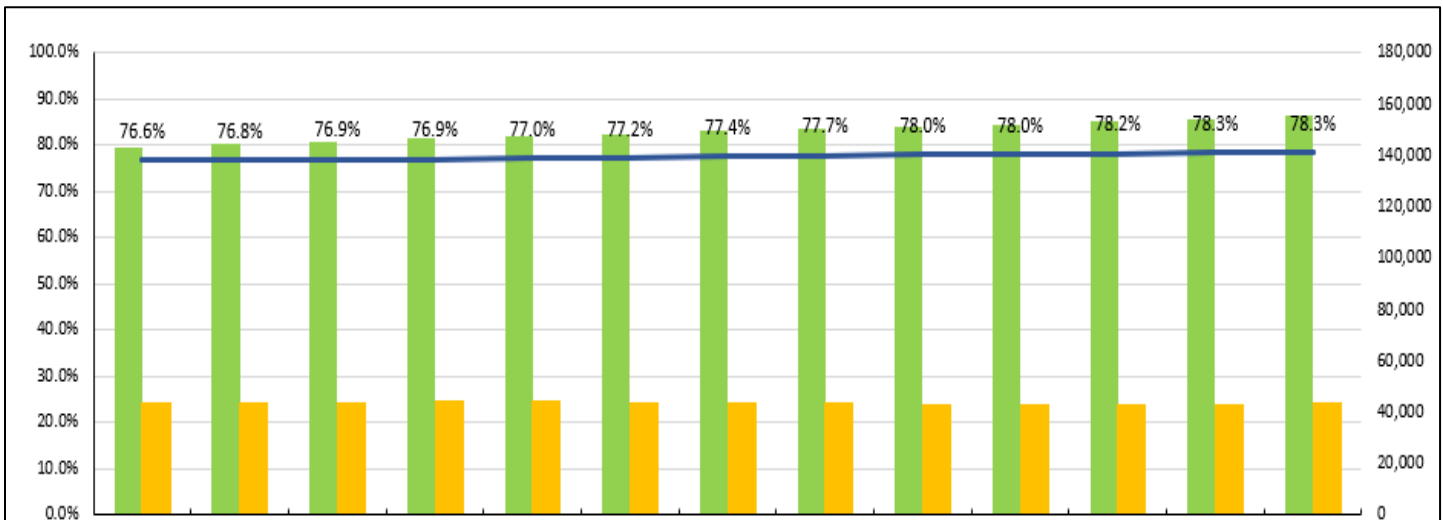




CHC Enrollments by County^{1,2}



Statewide LTSS Populations Plus HCBS Percentage



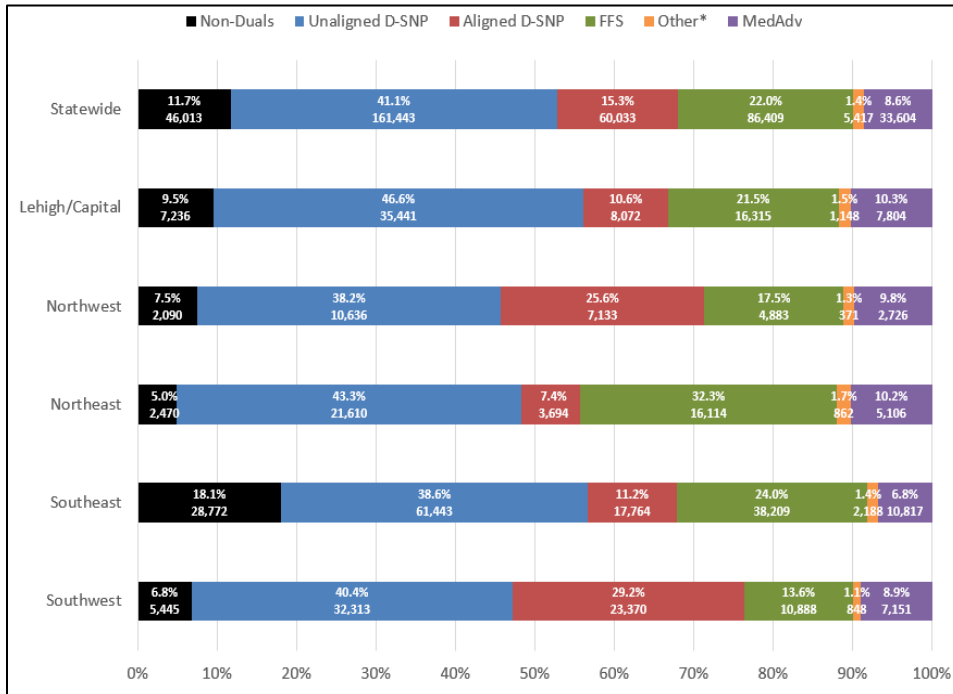

Summary:

In August, the statewide percentage of non-duals remained the same at 11.7%. The percentage of participants in aligned D-SNPs increased from 15.2% to 15.3%, and the percentage of participants in unaligned D-SNPs remained the same at 41.1%. The percentage of participants in FFS Medicare remained the same at 22.0%. Other Med. Advantage remained the same at 8.6%.

Medicare Type by CHC Zone and Plan

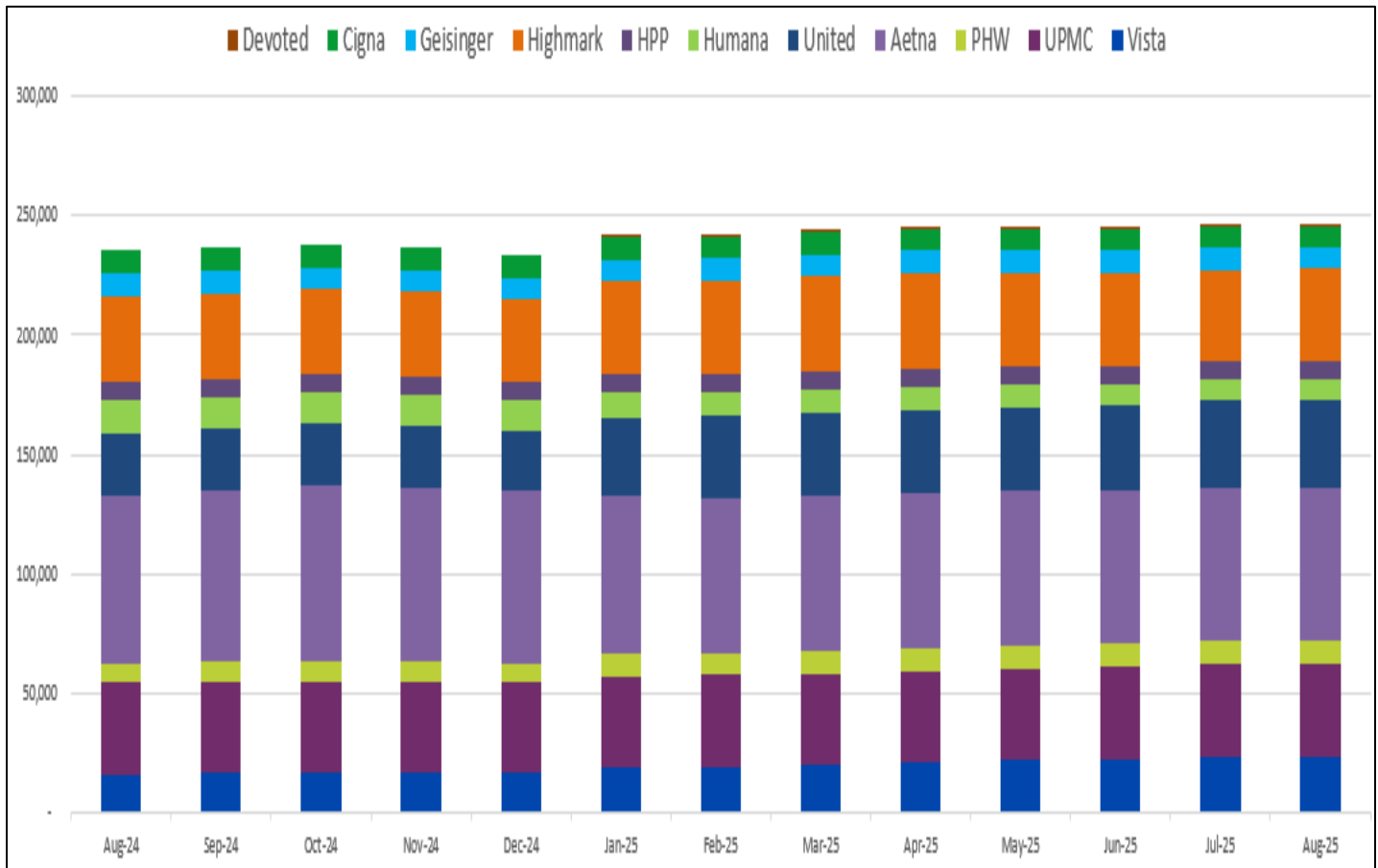

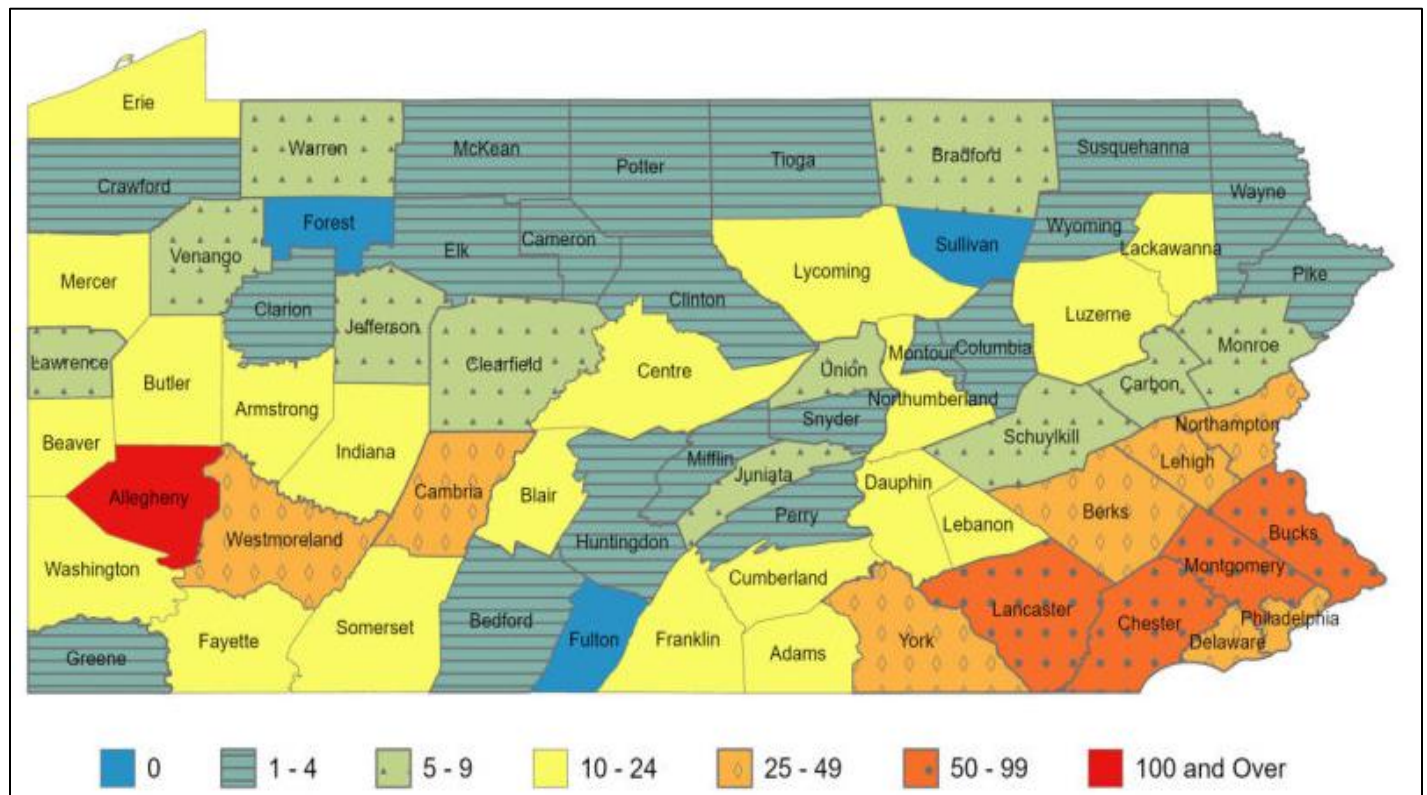
Number of Participant Choosing Participant Self-Direction*

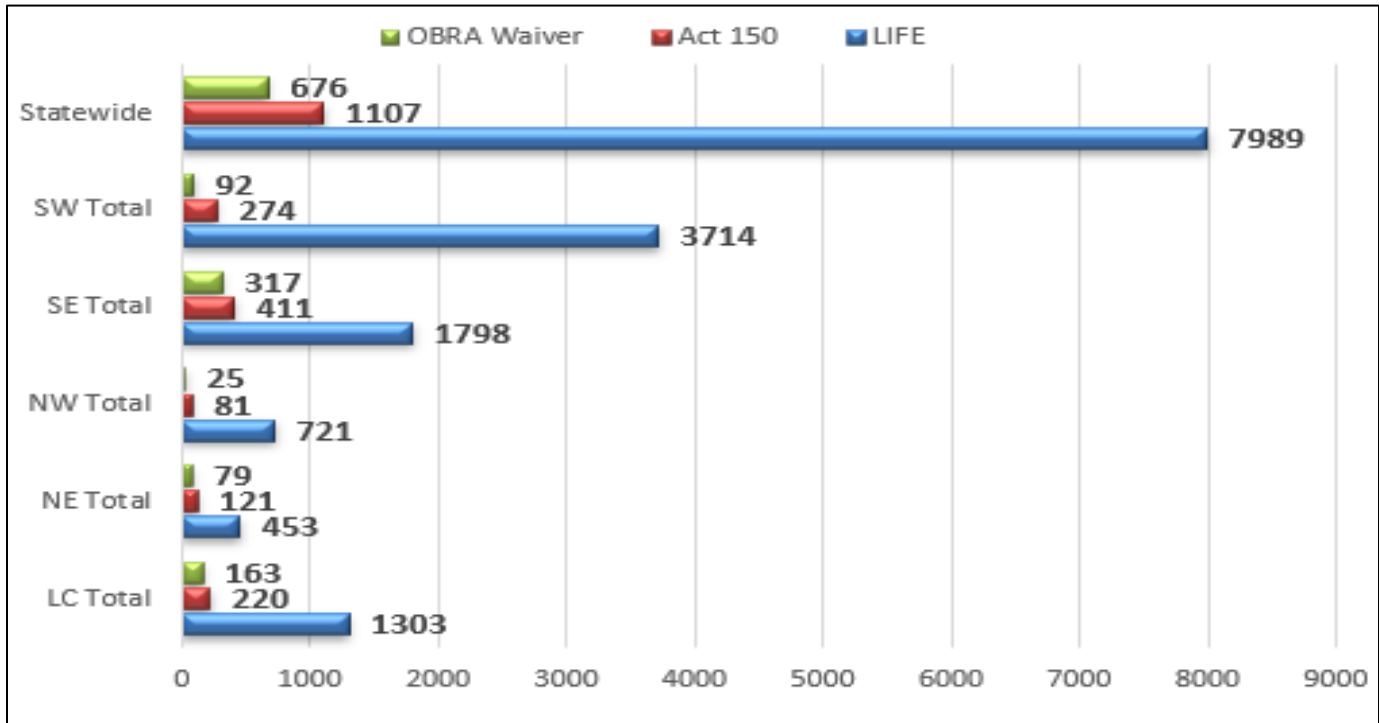

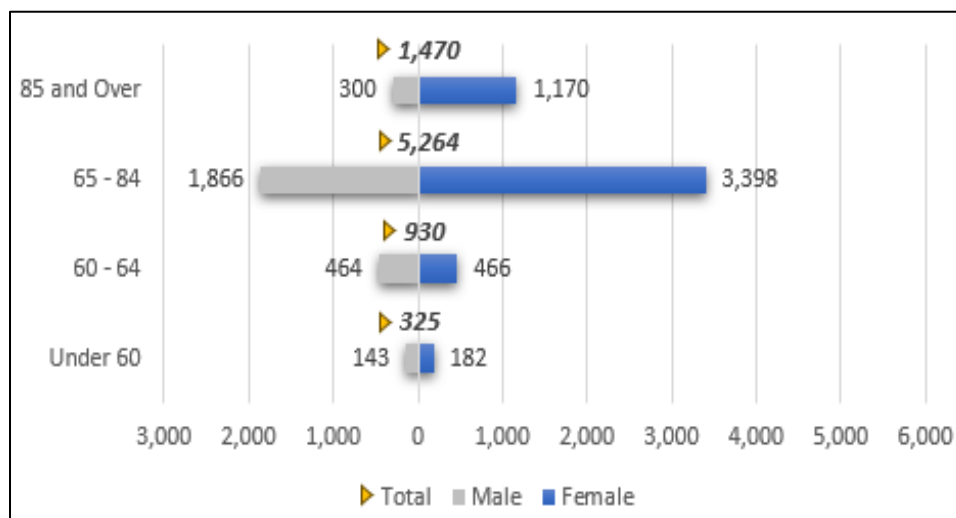
