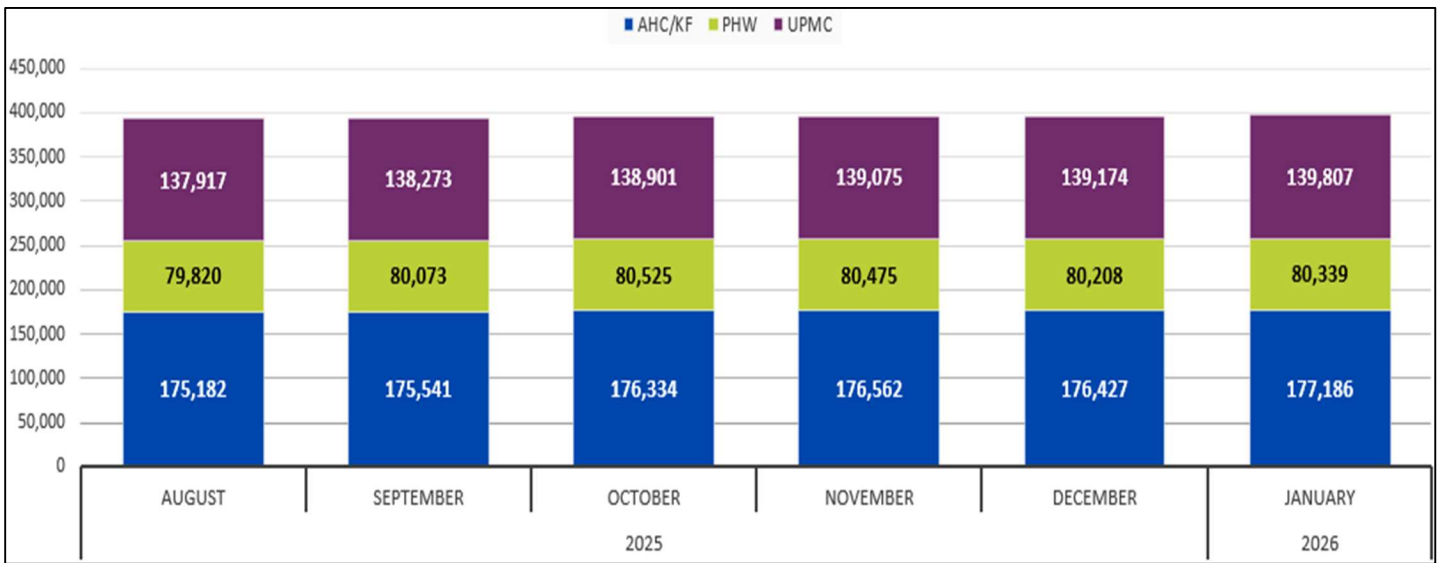

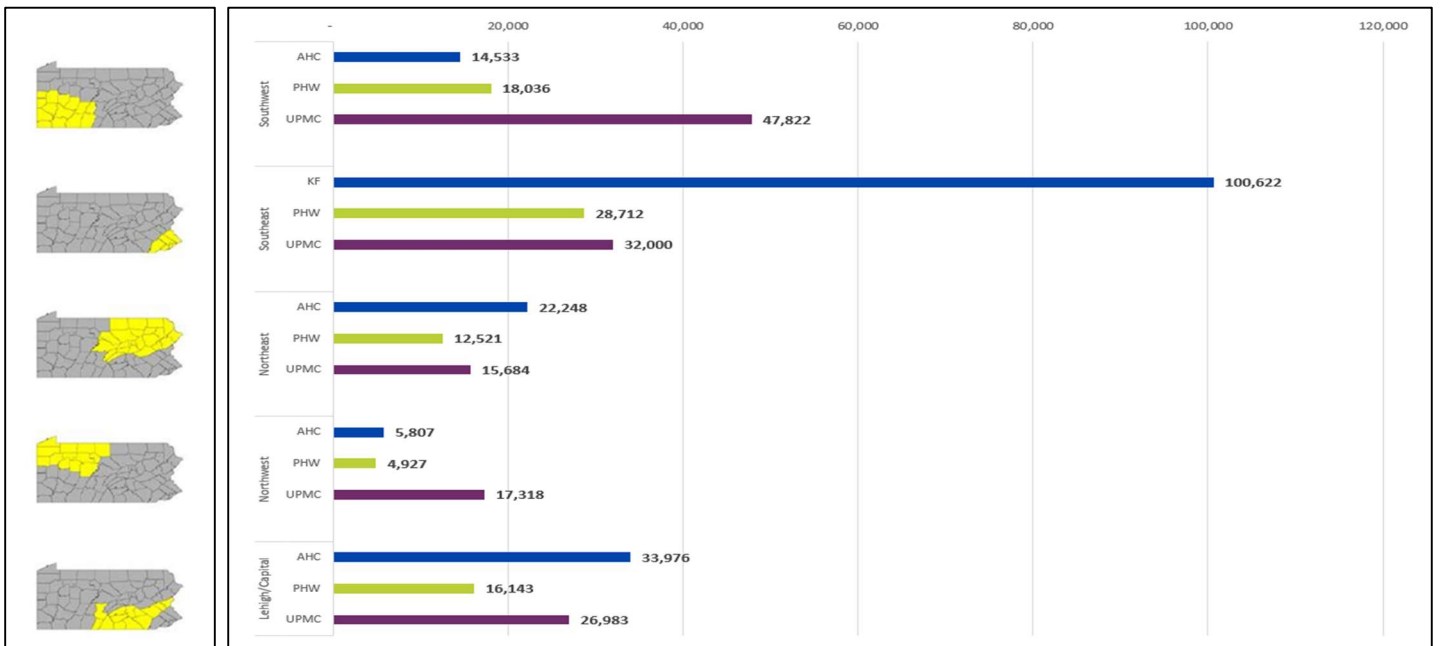

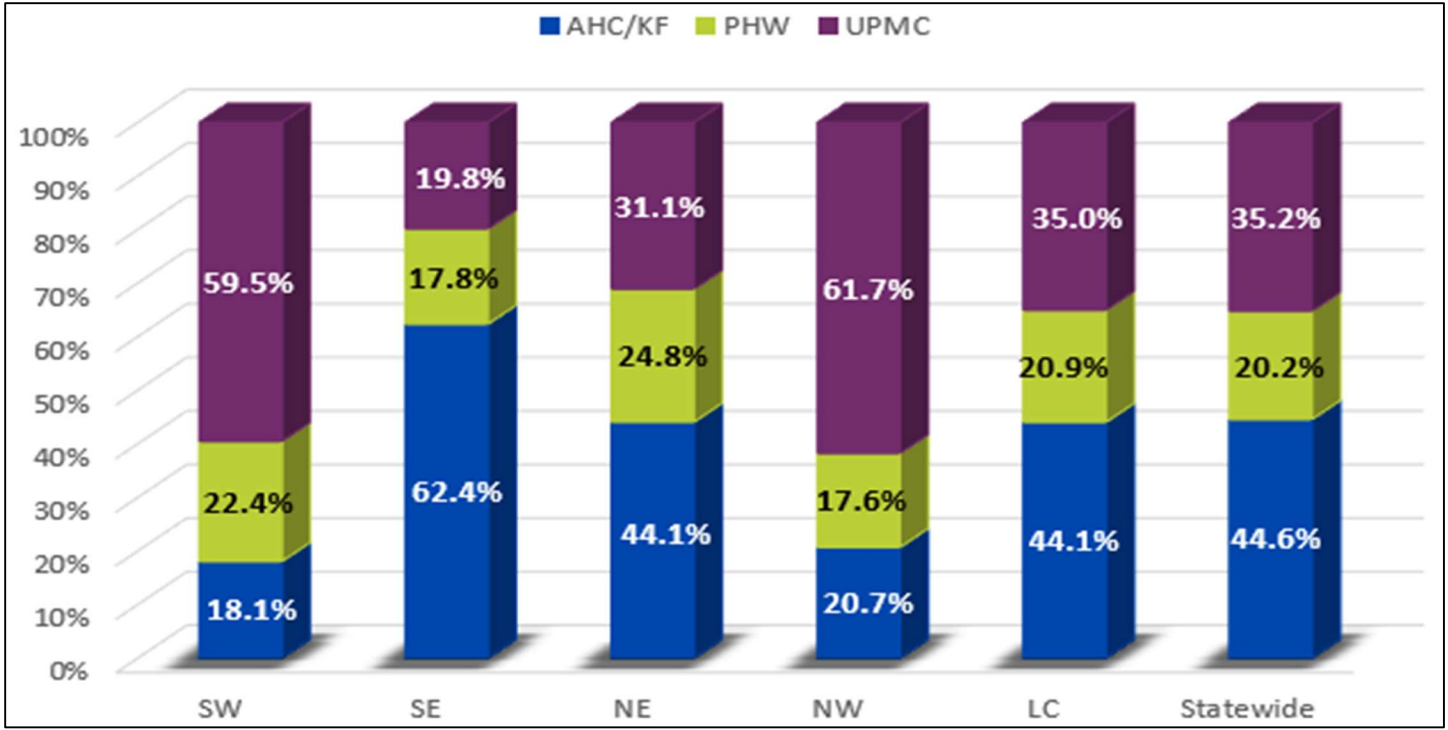

CHC Market Share Chart



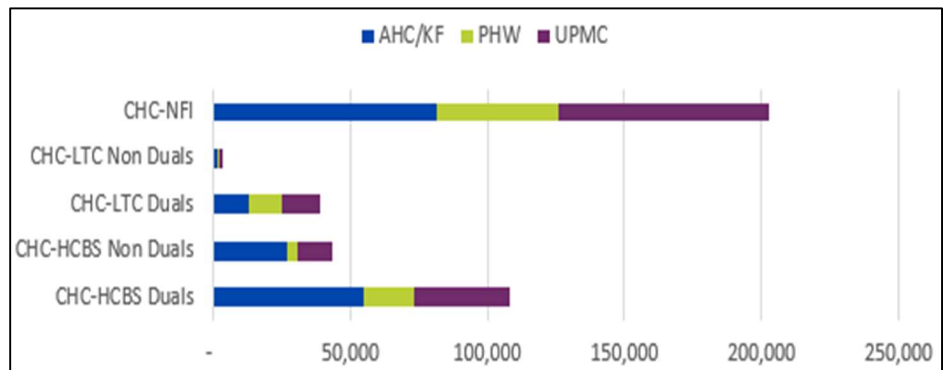

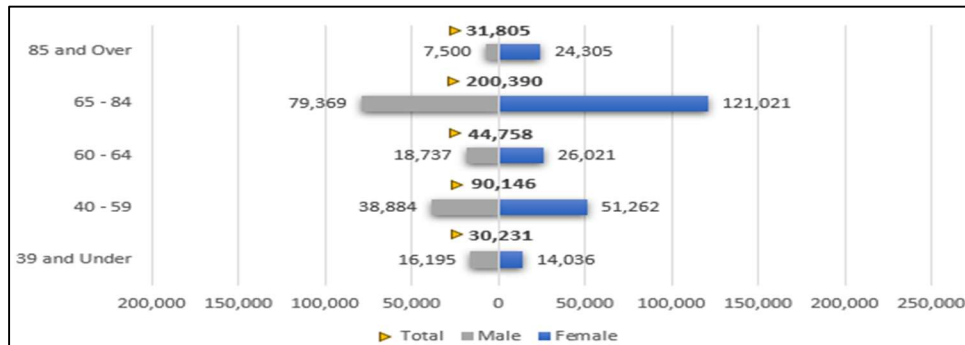

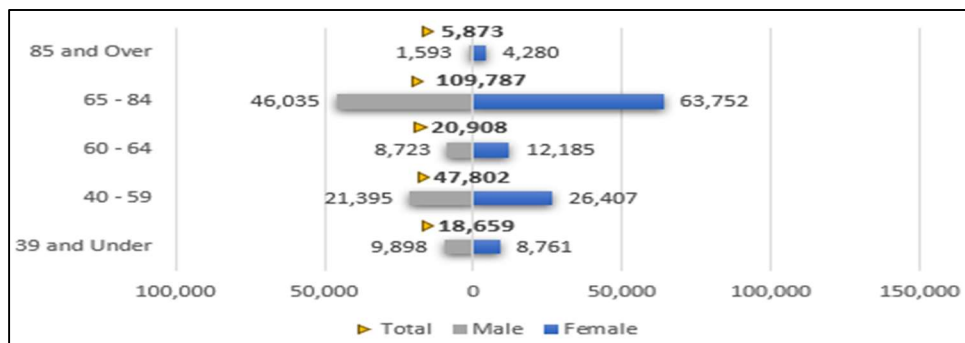


CHC Enrollments by Age, Gender, & Population Groups

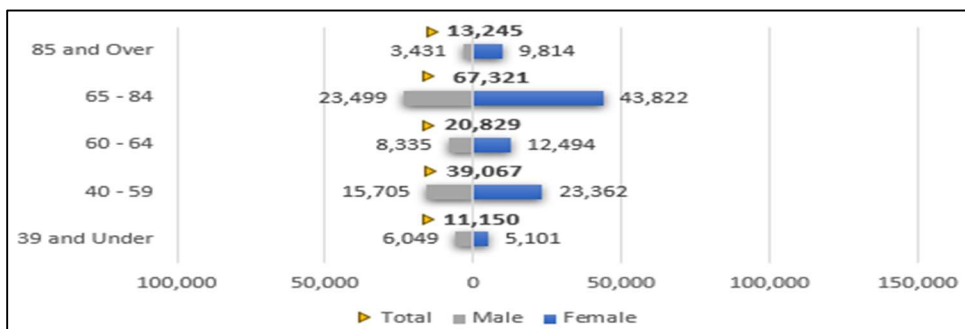
CHC by Gender and Age Group



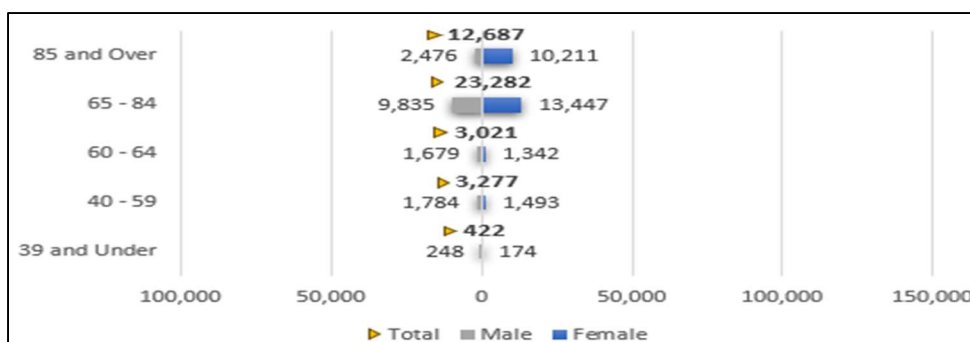
CHC-NFI by Gender and Age Group



CHC-HCBS by Gender and Age Group



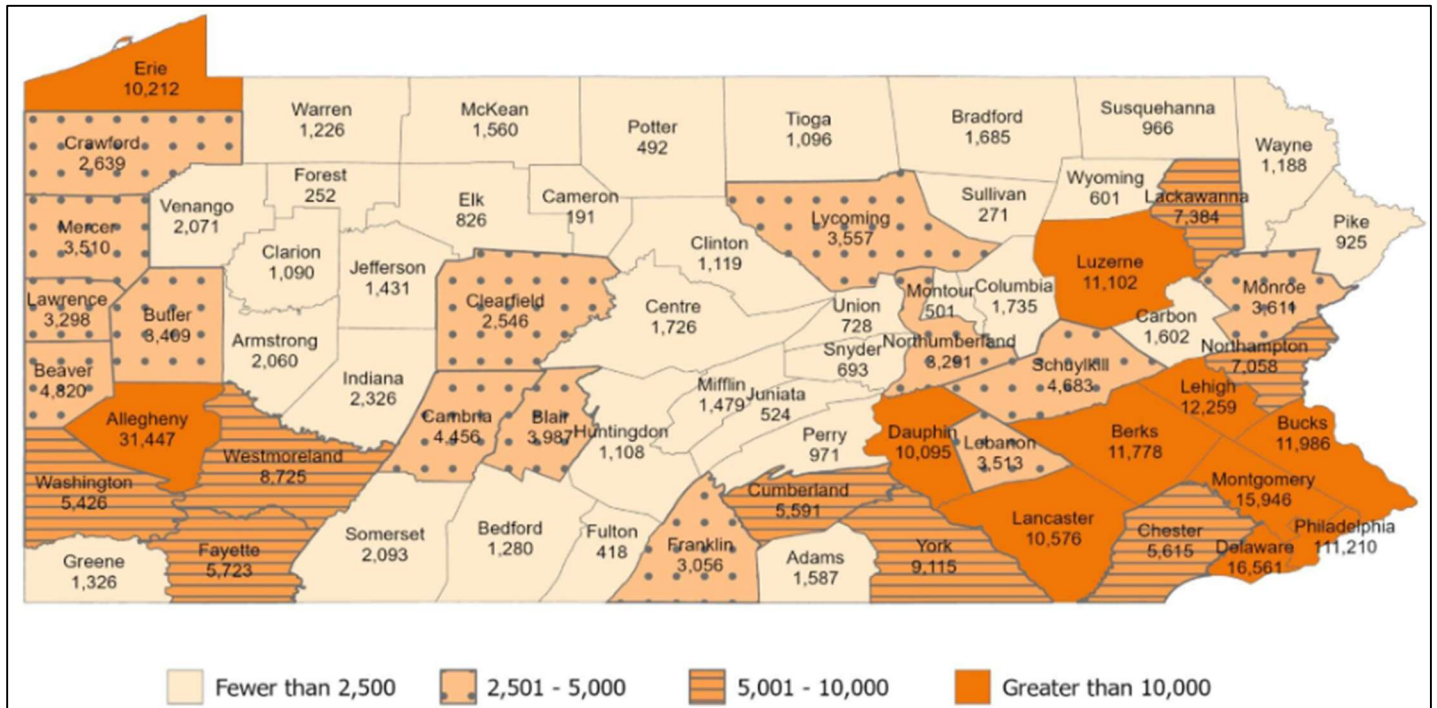
CHC-LTC by Gender and Age Group



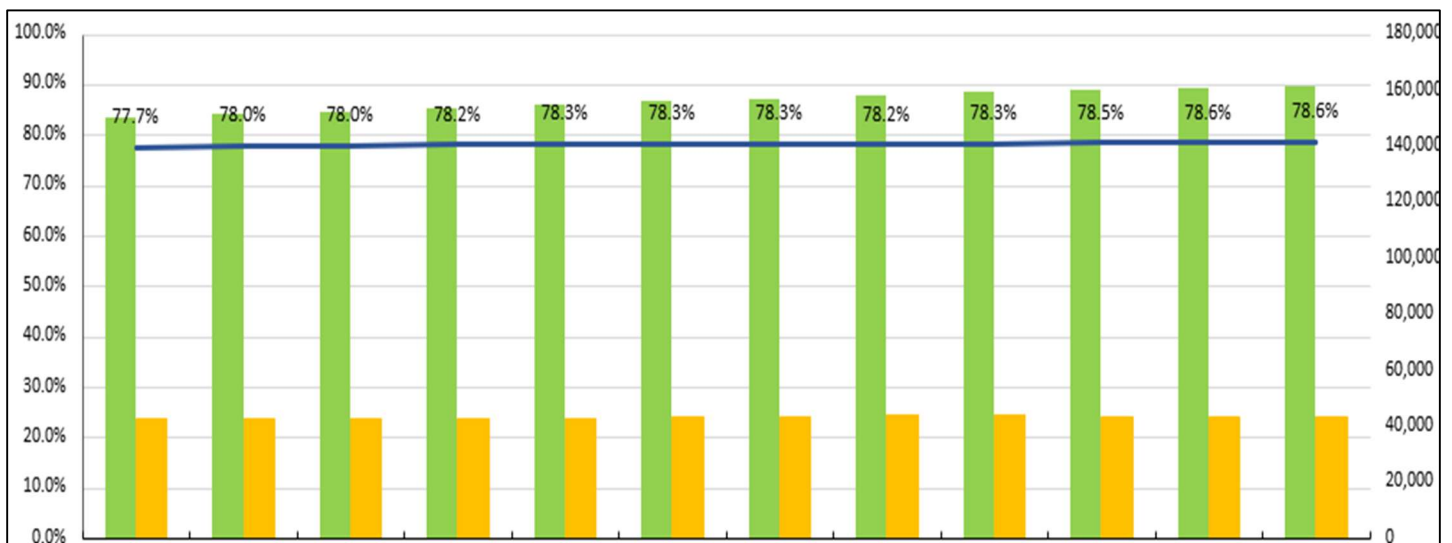

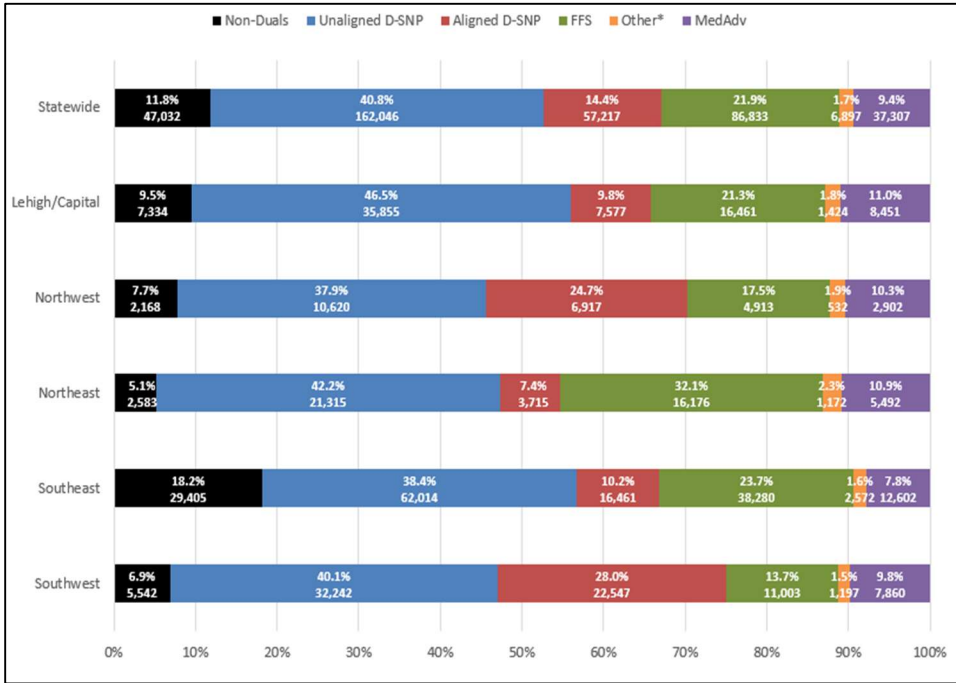

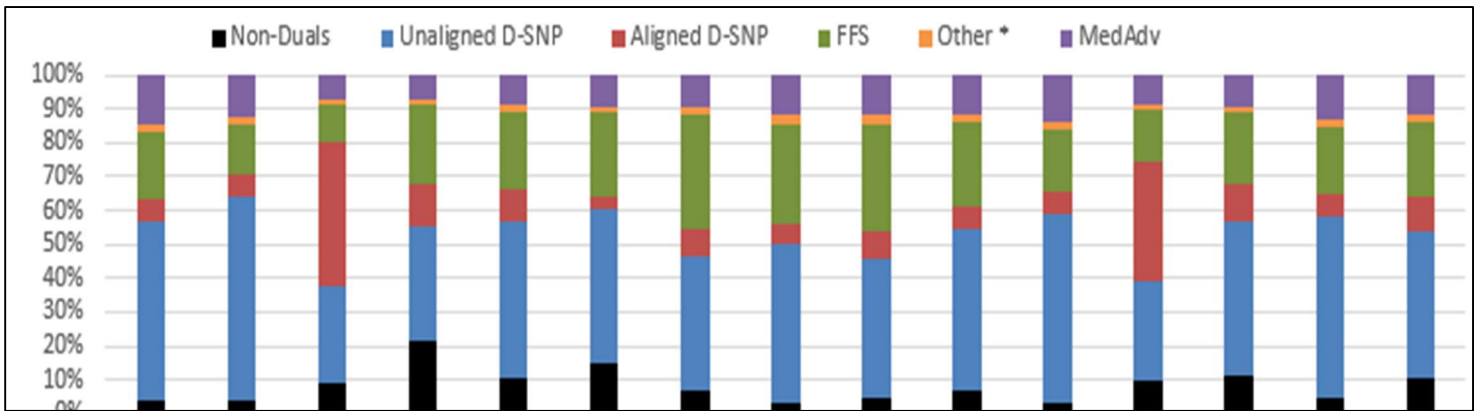
Medicare Type for All CHC Participants by Region^{3,4}



Summary:

In January, the statewide percentage of non-duals remained the same at 11.8%. The percentage of participants in aligned D-SNPs decreased from 15.1% to 14.4%, and the percentage of participants in unaligned D-SNPs increased from 39.5% to 40.8%. The percentage of participants in FFS Medicare decreased from 22.3% to 21.9%. Other Med. Advantage increased from 9.3% to 9.4%.

Medicare Type by CHC Zone and Plan

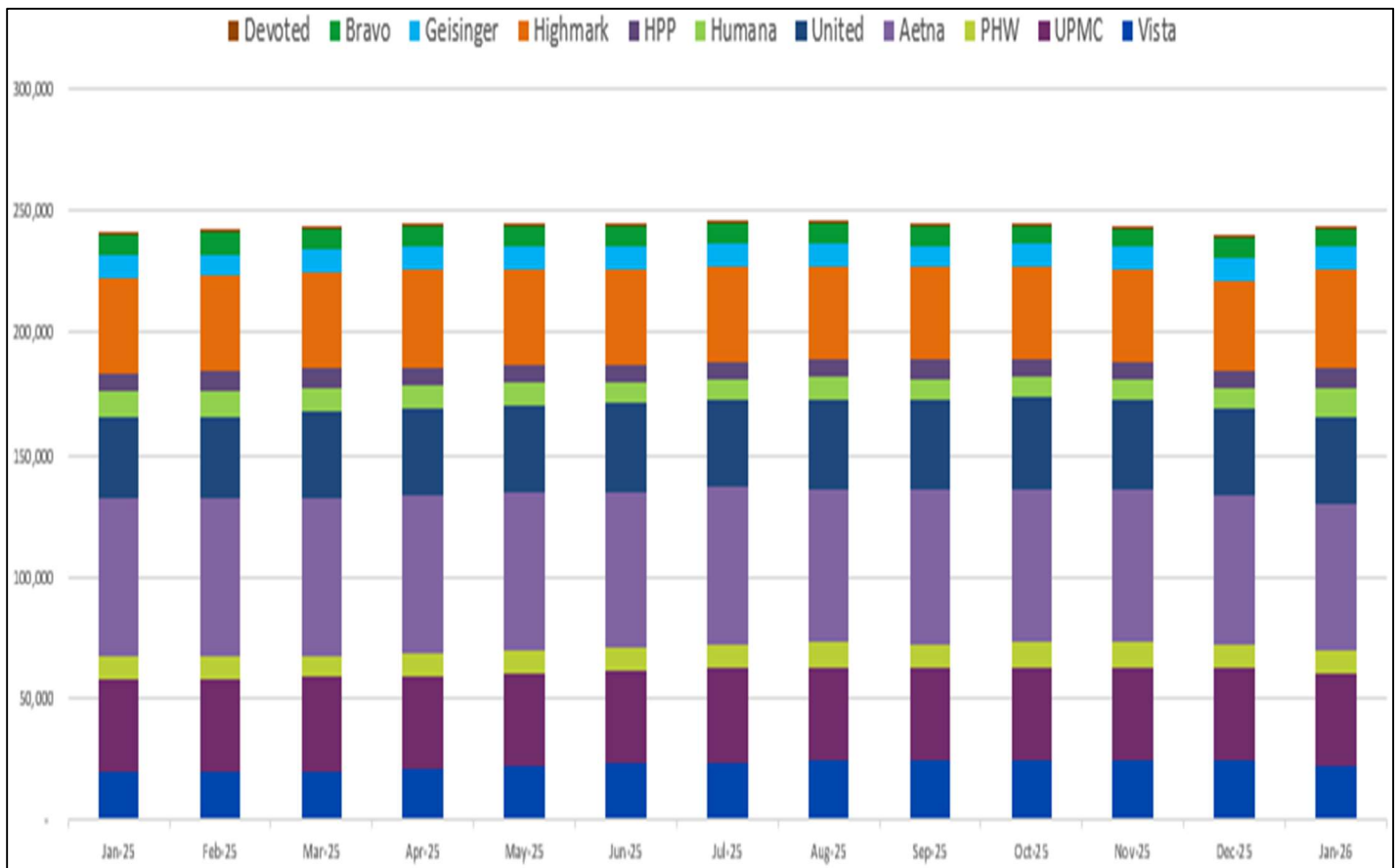

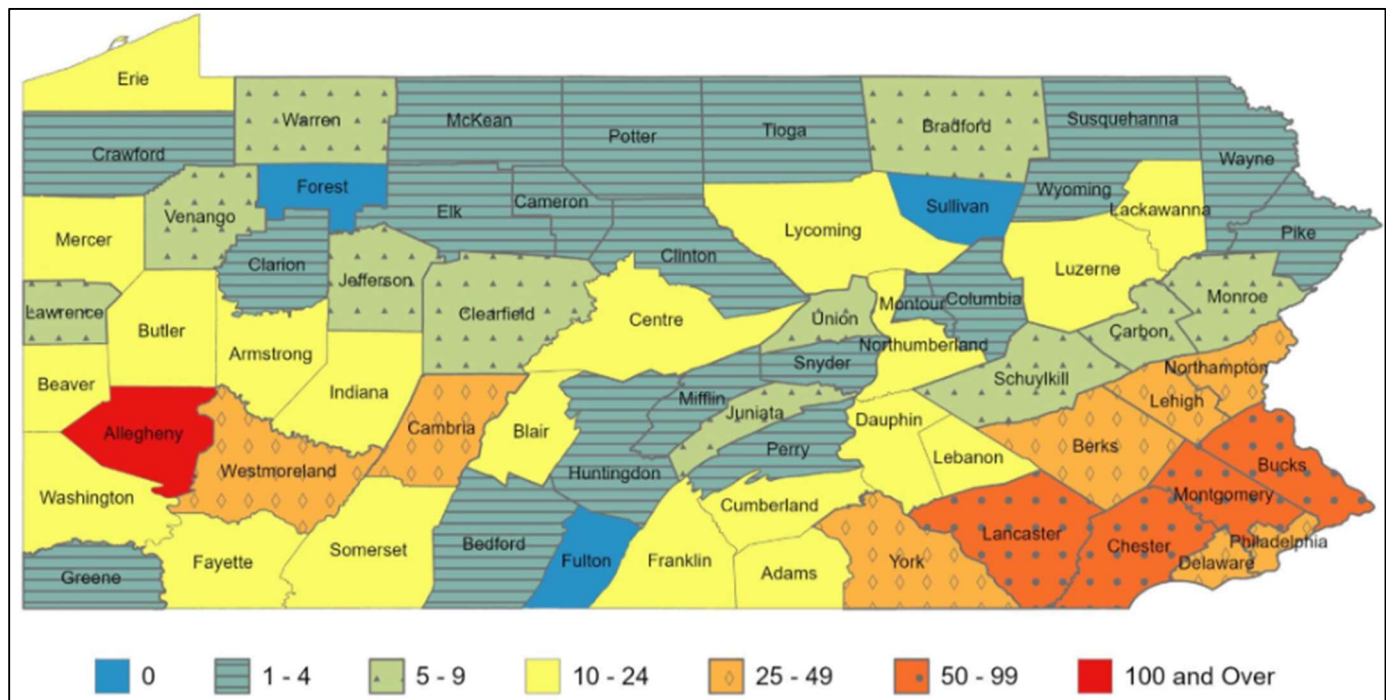
Number of Participant Choosing Participant Self-Direction*

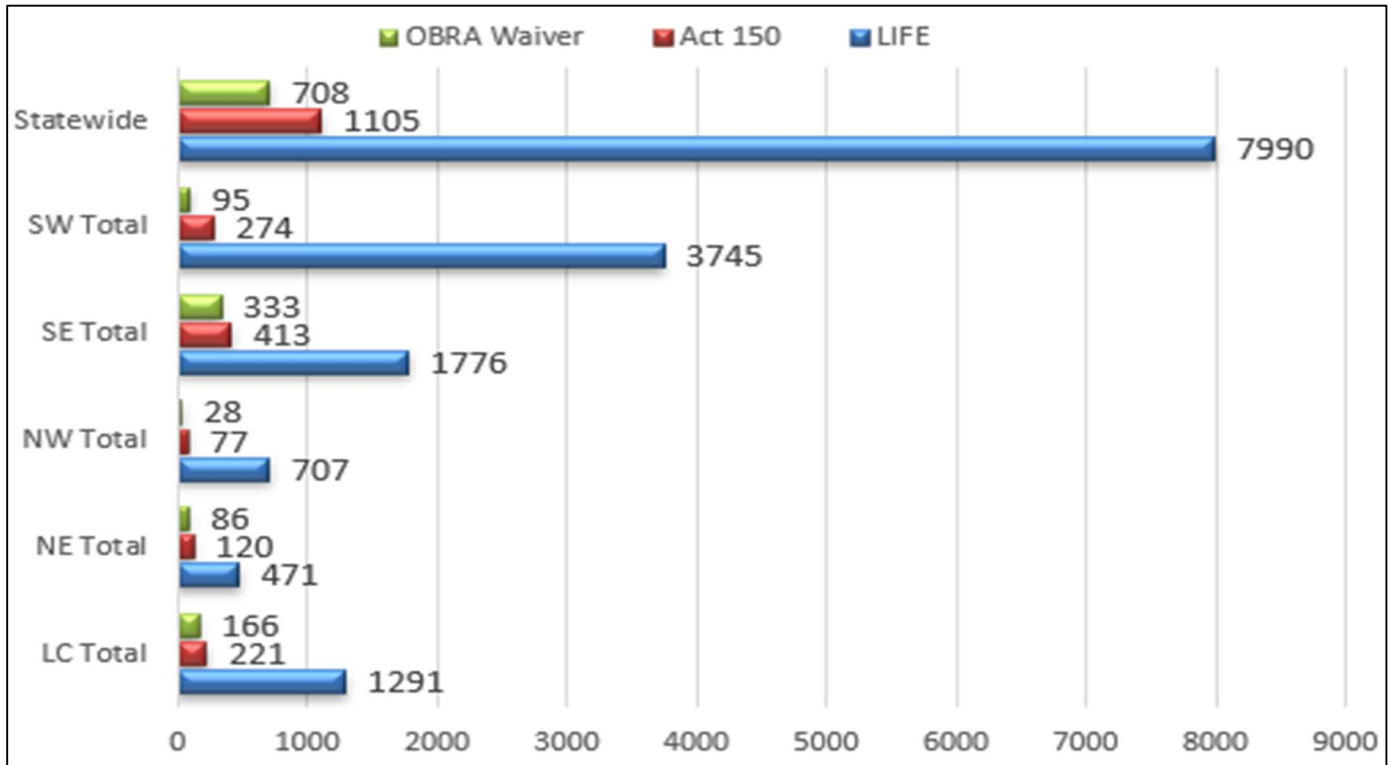

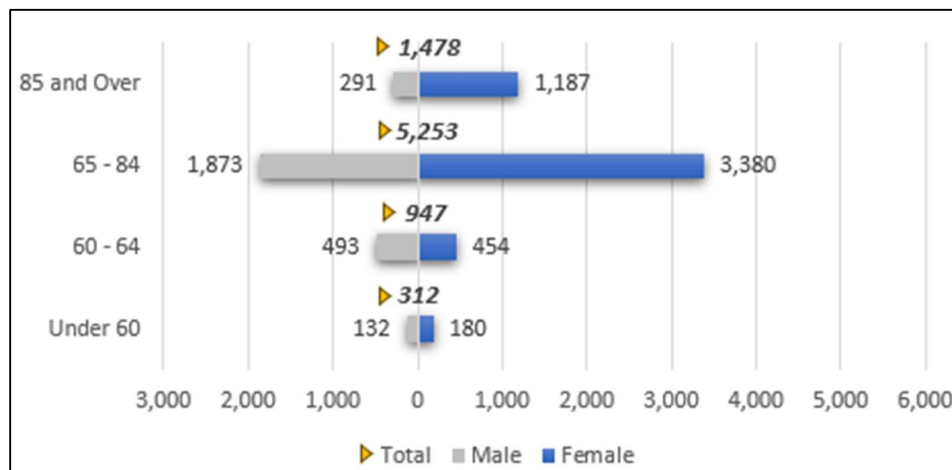
