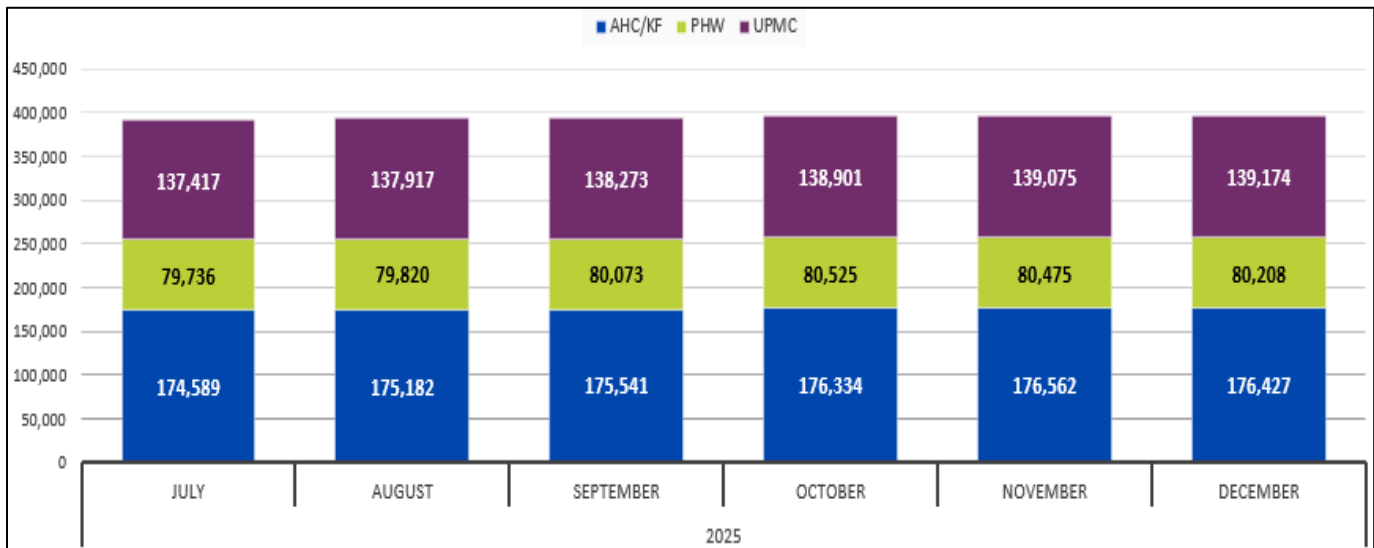

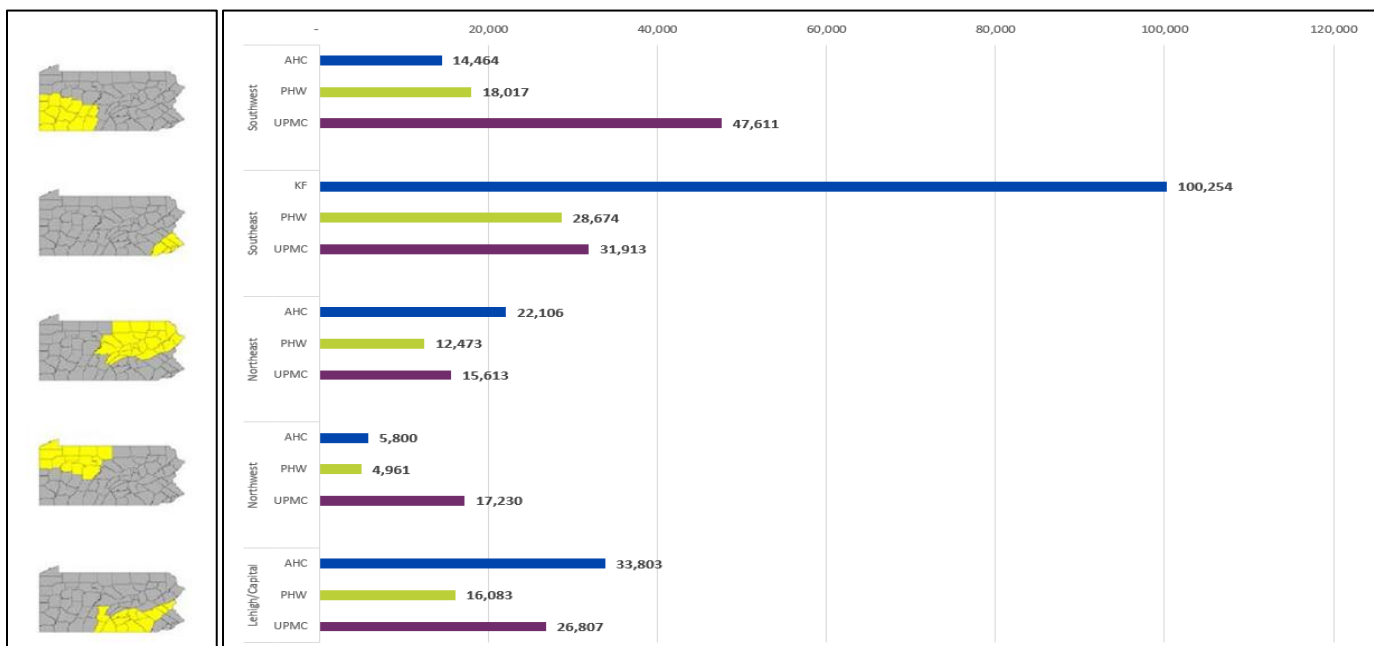

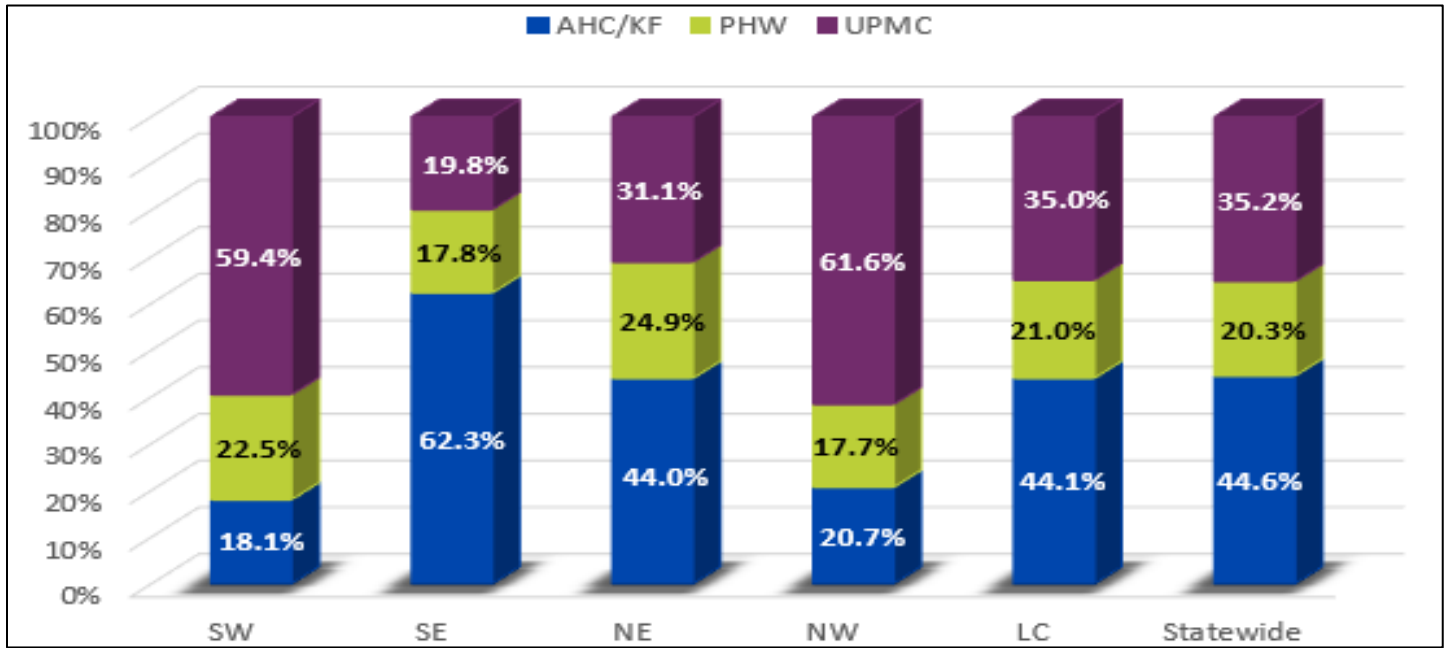

CHC Market Share Chart



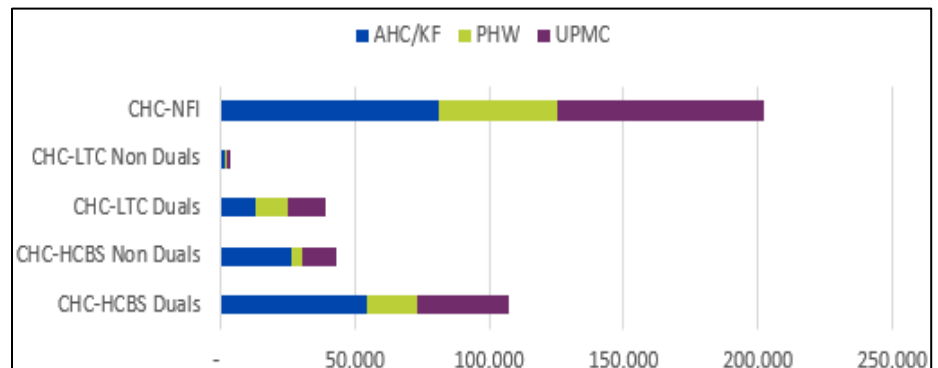

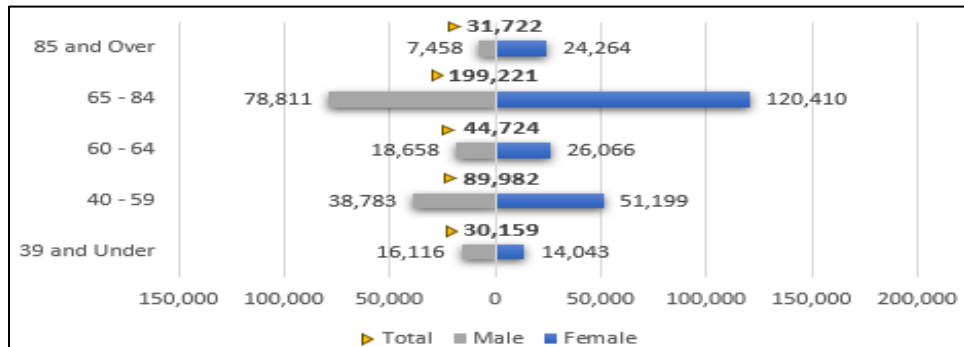

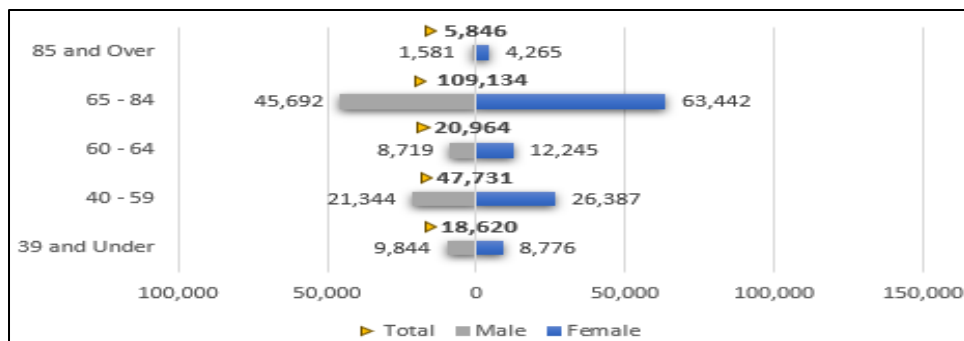


CHC Enrollments by Age, Gender, & Population Groups

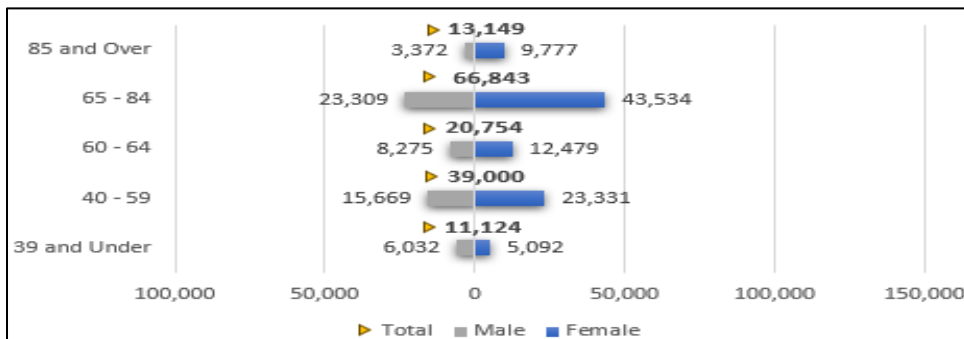
CHC by Gender and Age Group



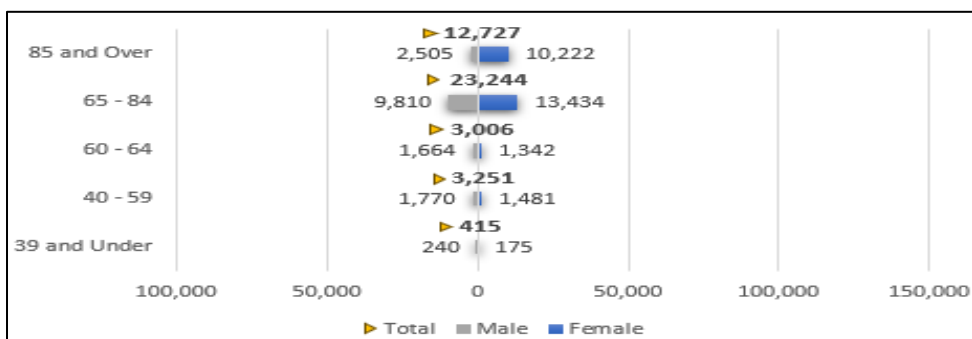
CHC-NFI by Gender and Age Group



CHC-HCBS by Gender and Age Group

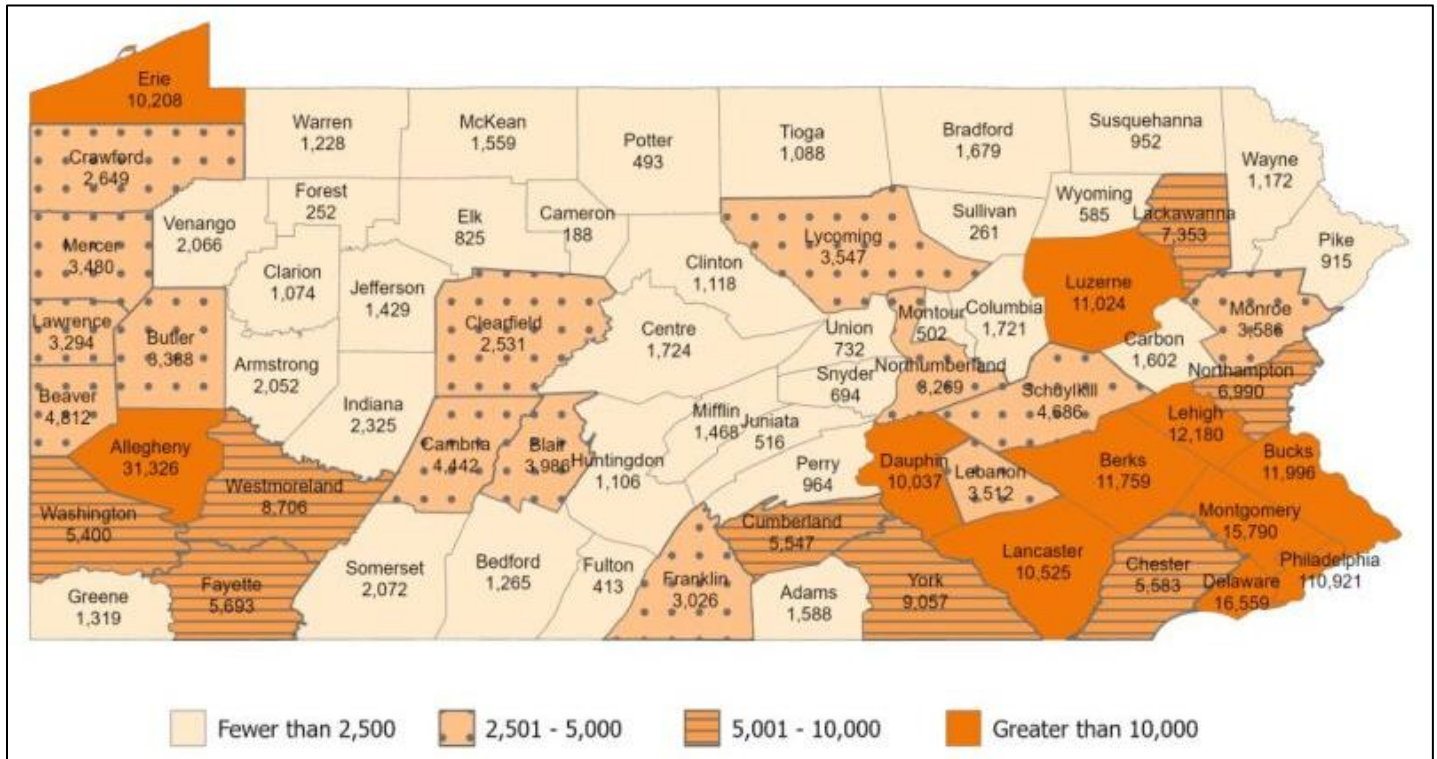


CHC-LTC by Gender and Age Group

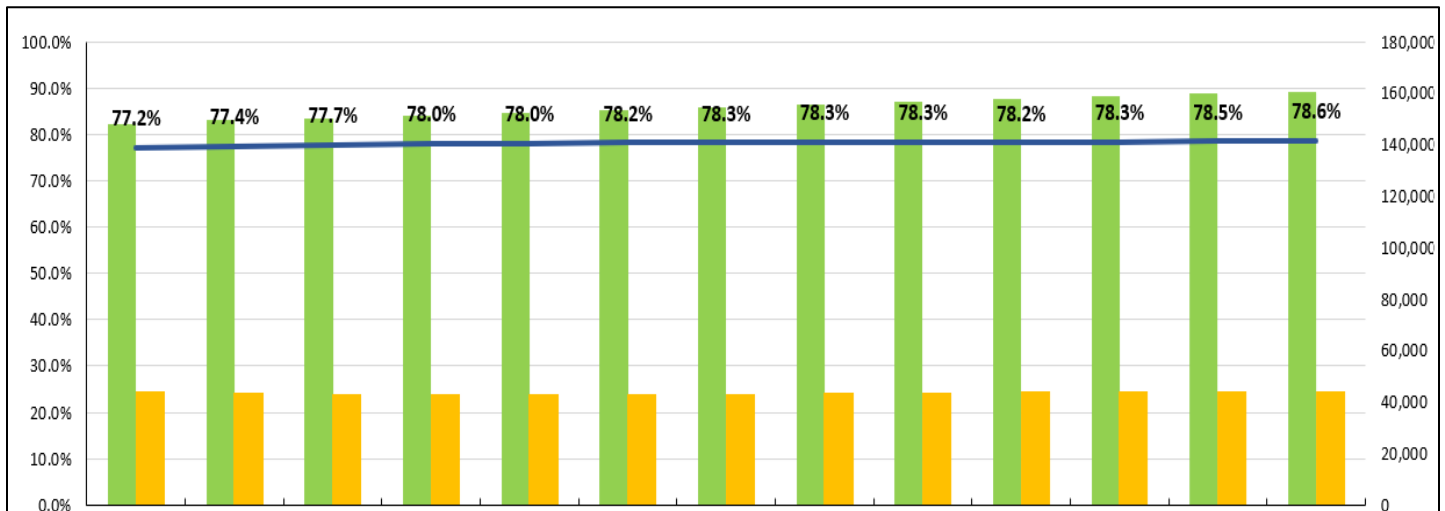




CHC Enrollments by County^{1,2}



Statewide LTSS Populations Plus HCBS Percentage



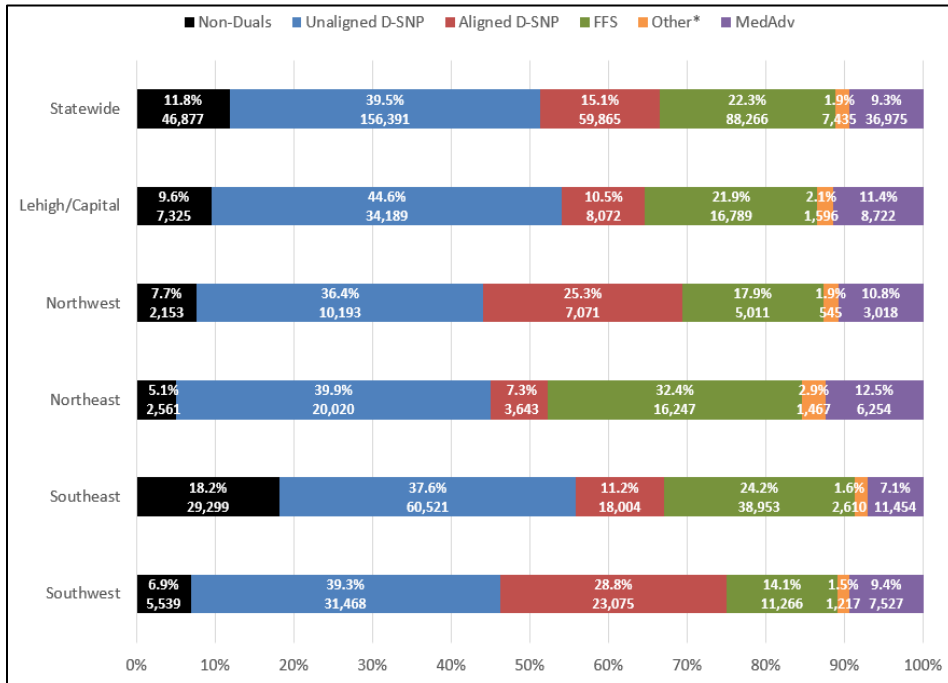

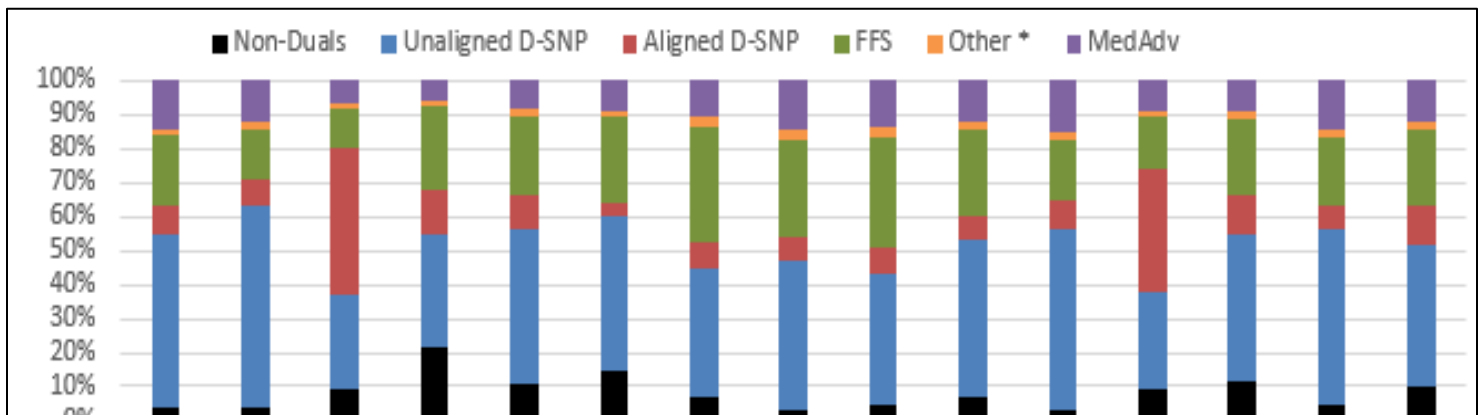
Medicare Type for All CHC Participants by Region^{3,4}



Summary:

In December, the statewide percentage of non-duals remained the same at 11.8%. The percentage of participants in aligned D-SNPs decreased from 15.3% to 15.1%, and the percentage of participants in unaligned D-SNPs decreased from 40.5% to 39.5%. The percentage of participants in FFS Medicare increased from 22.2% to 22.3%. Other Med. Advantage increased from 8.7% to 9.3%.

Medicare Type by CHC Zone and Plan

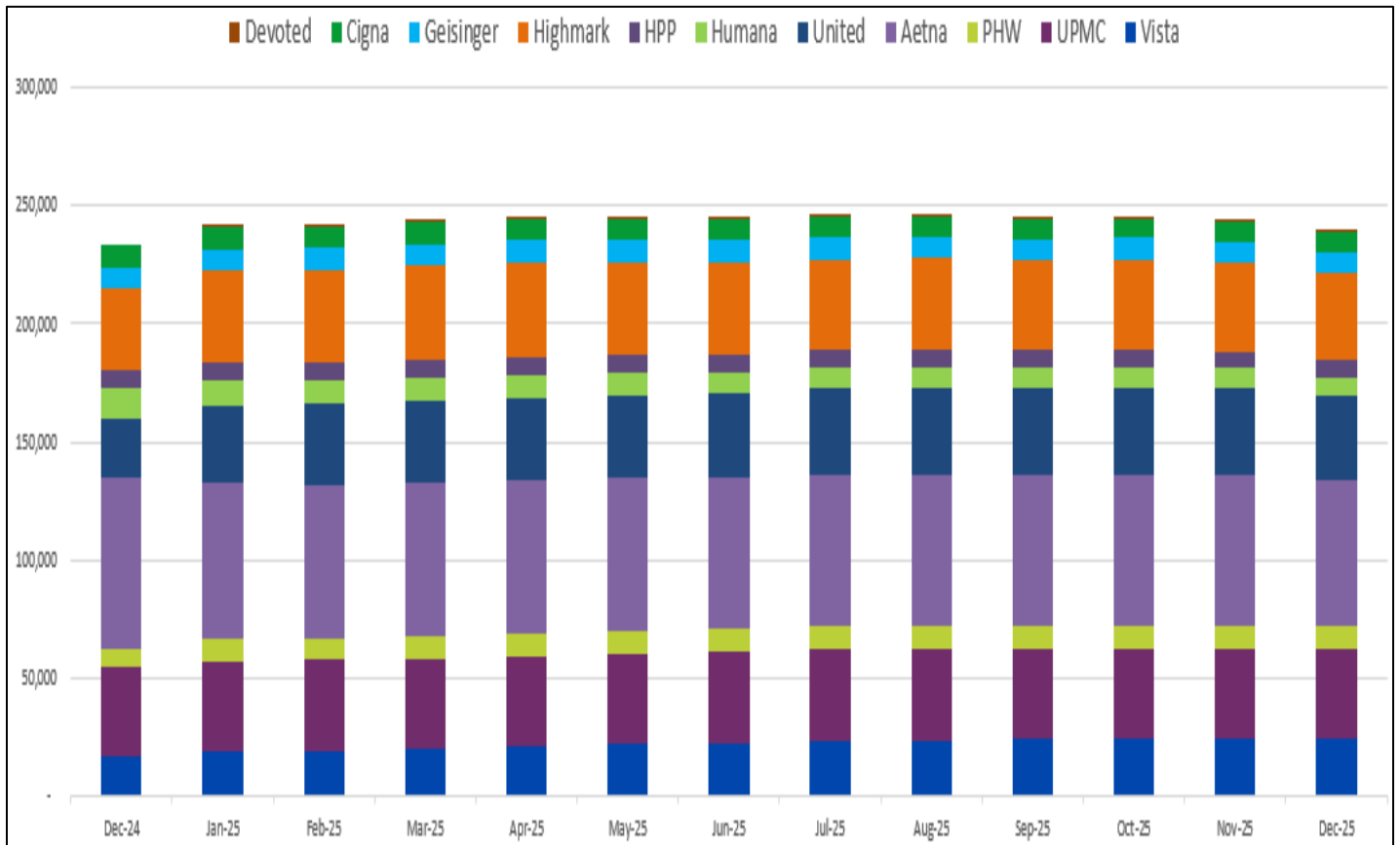

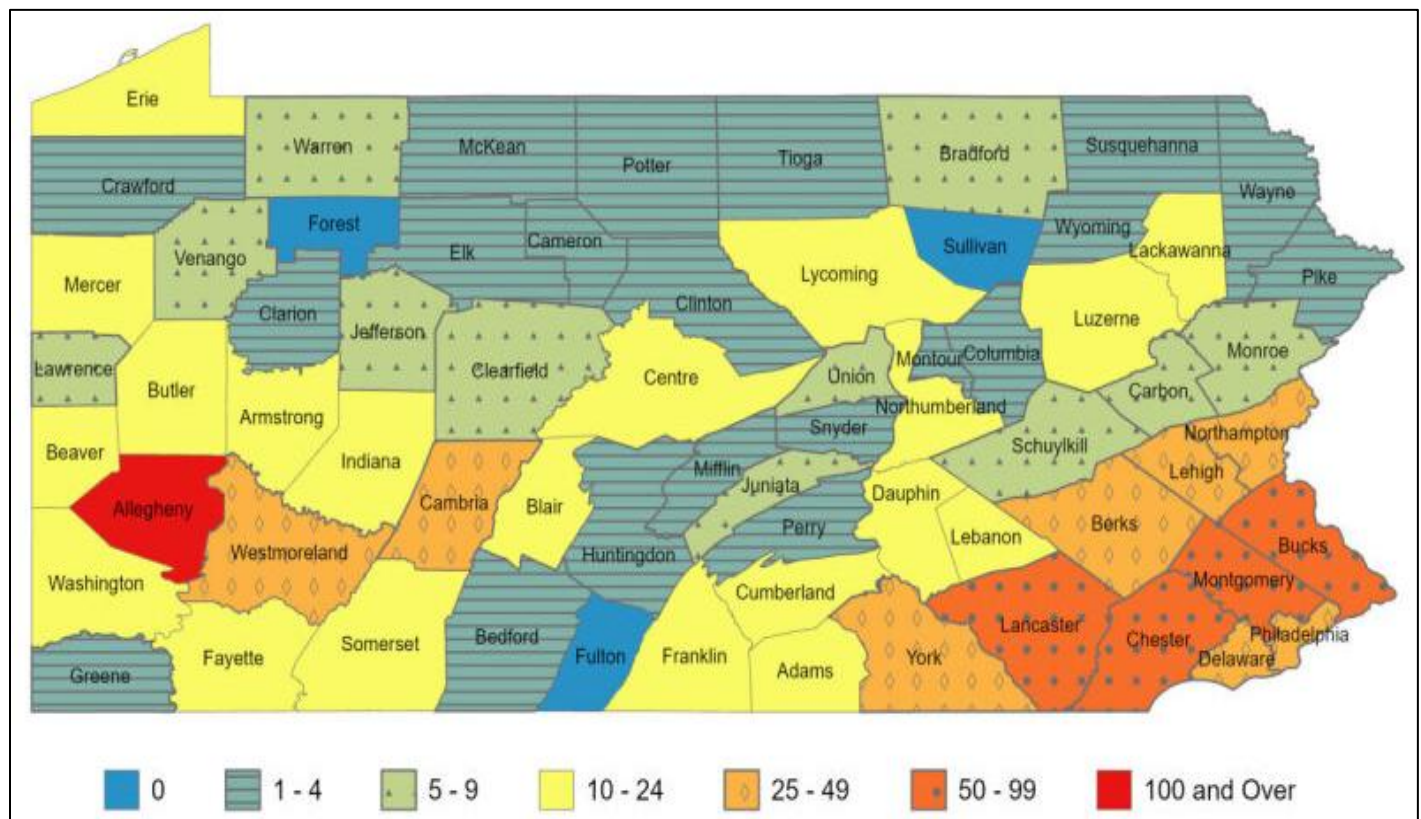
Number of Participant Choosing Participant Self-Direction*

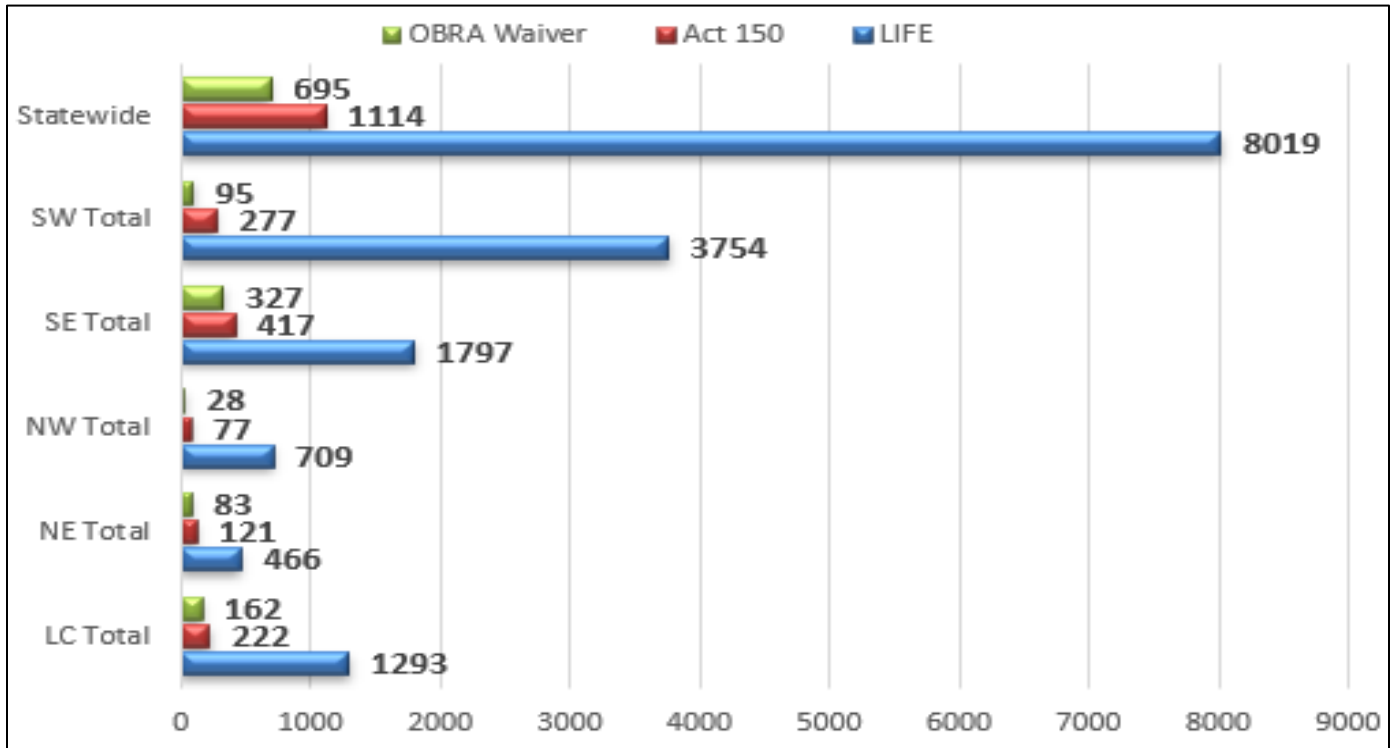

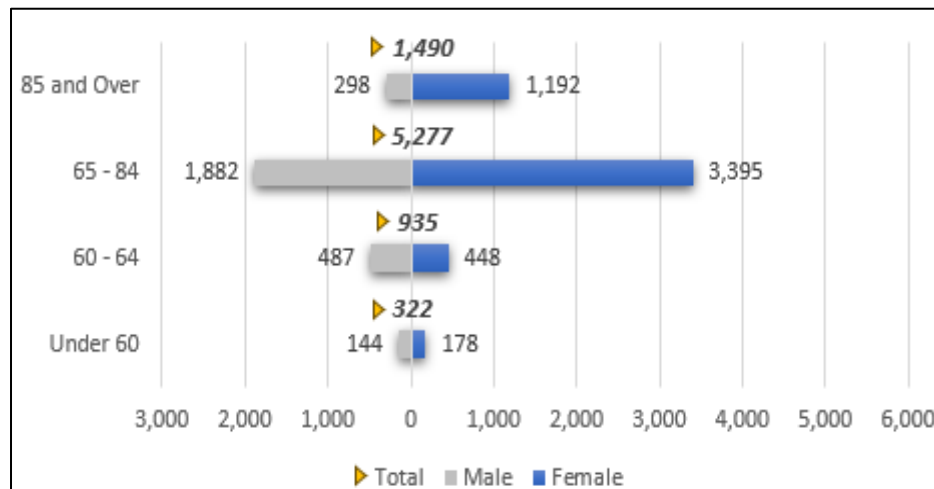
