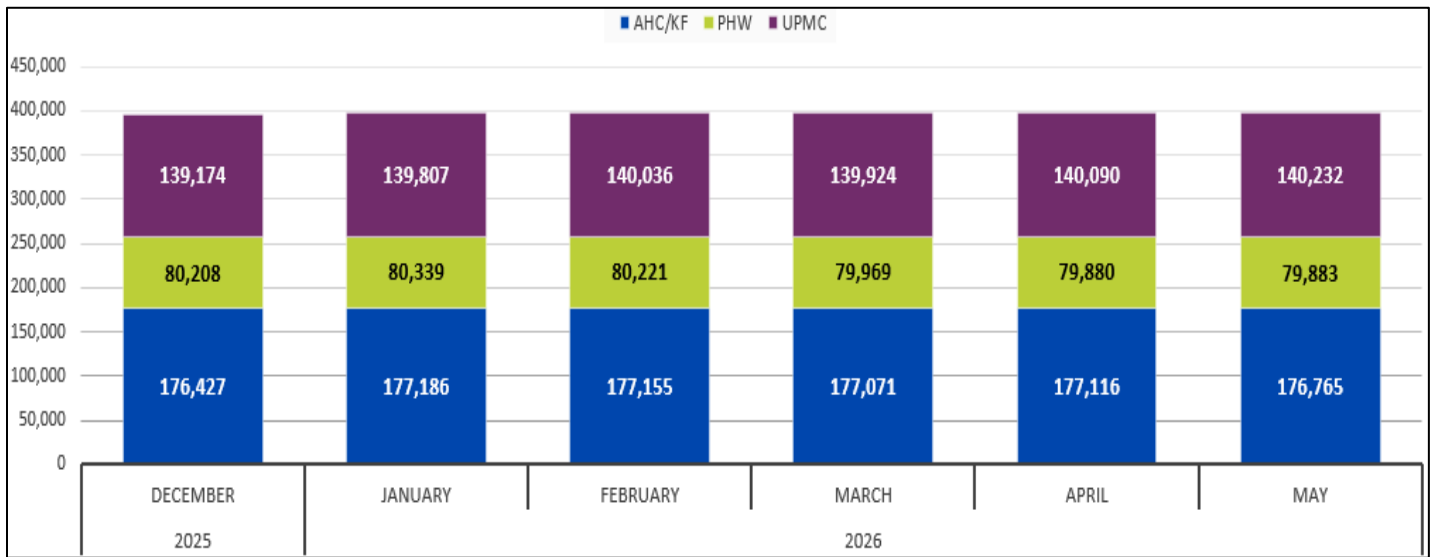

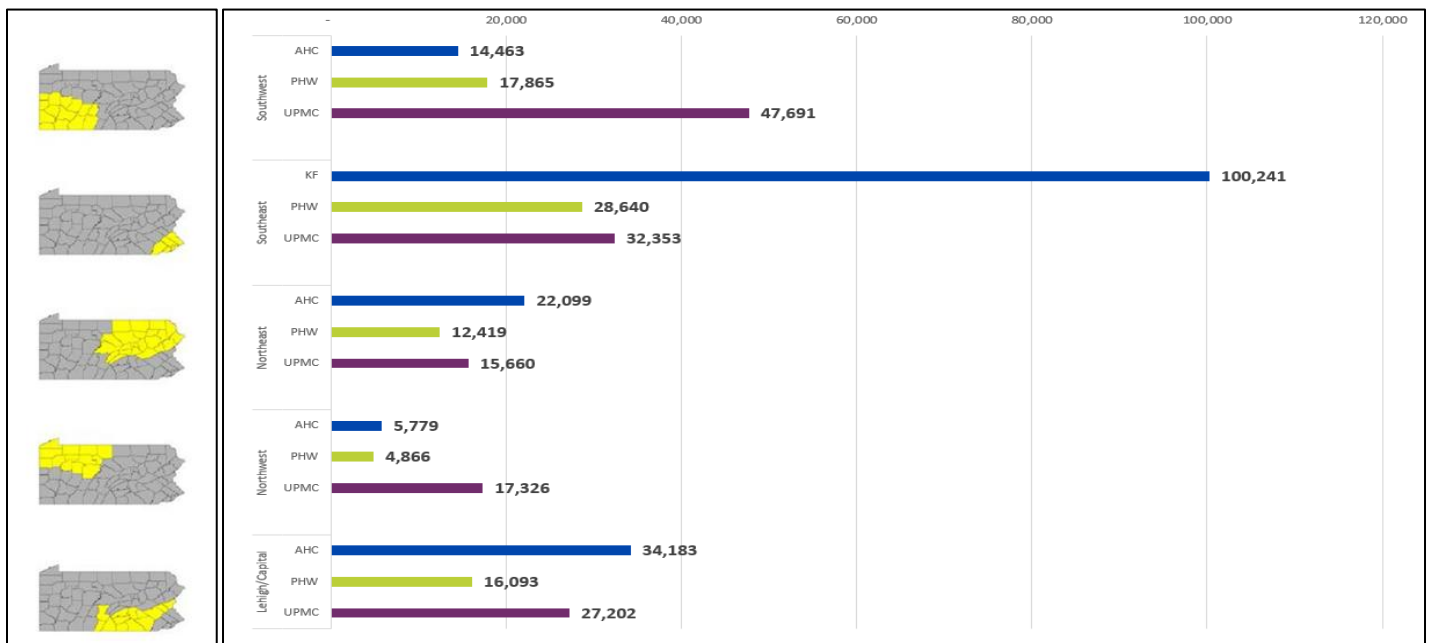

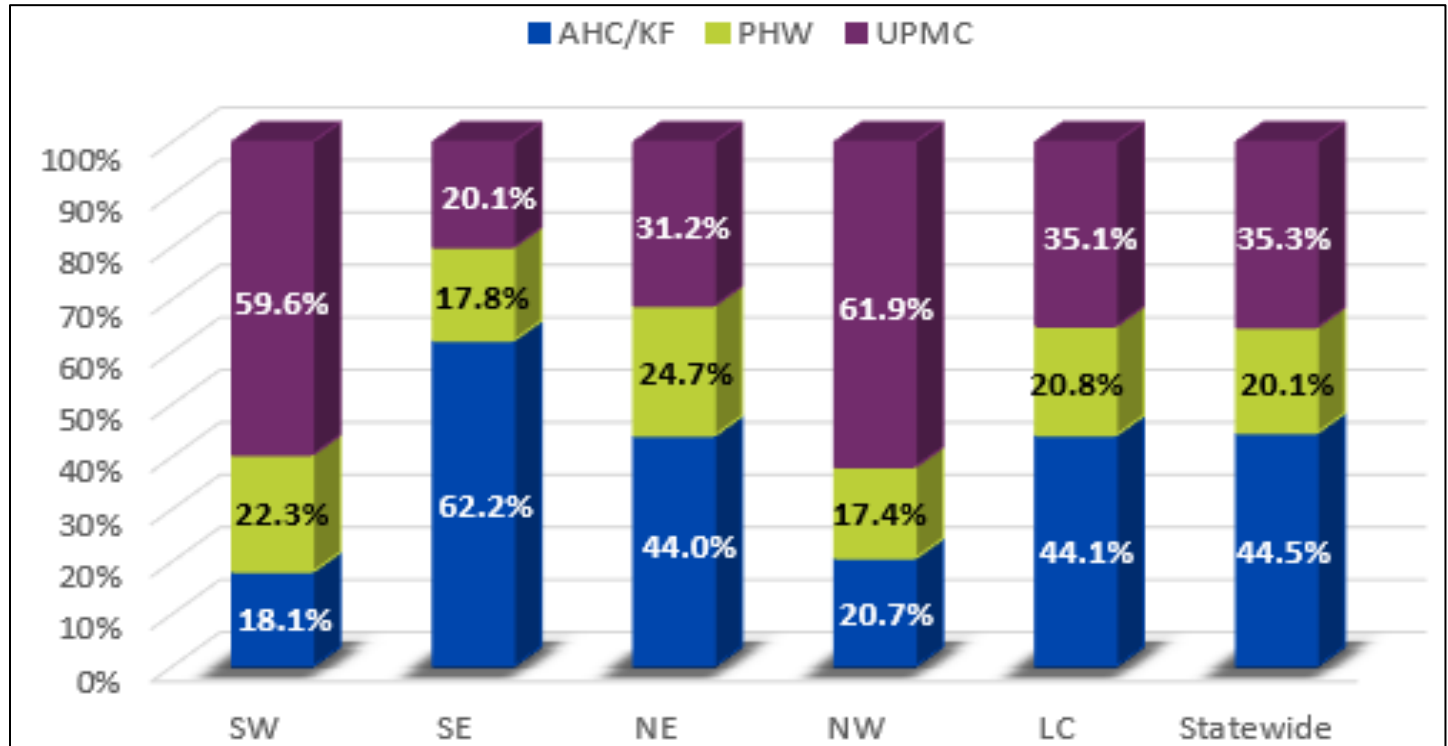

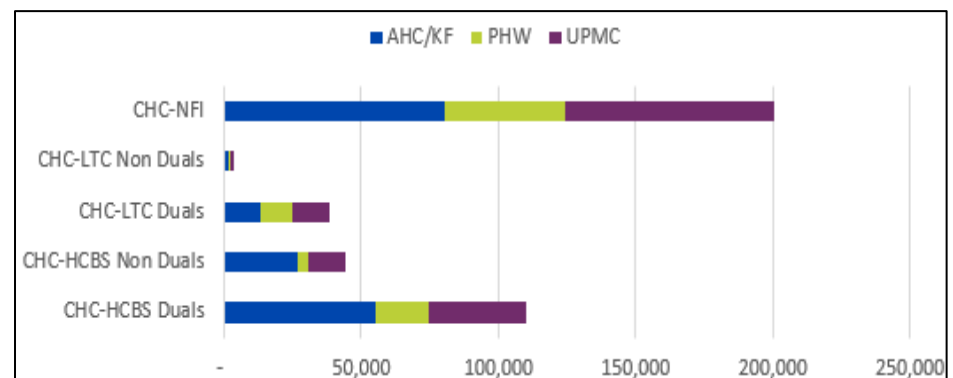

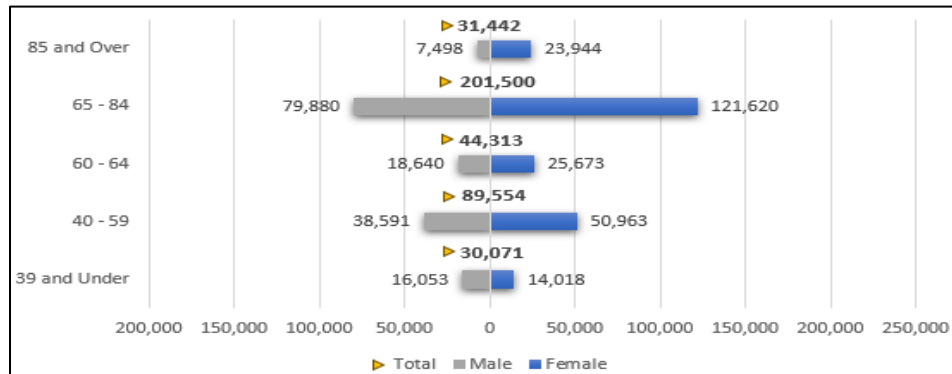

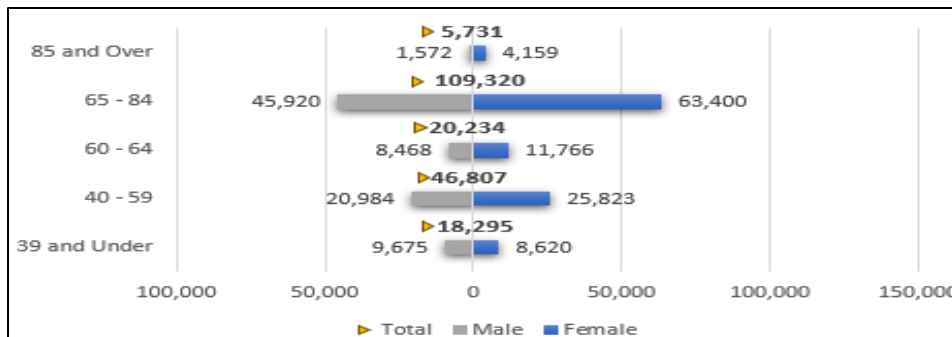


CHC Enrollments by Age, Gender, & Population Groups

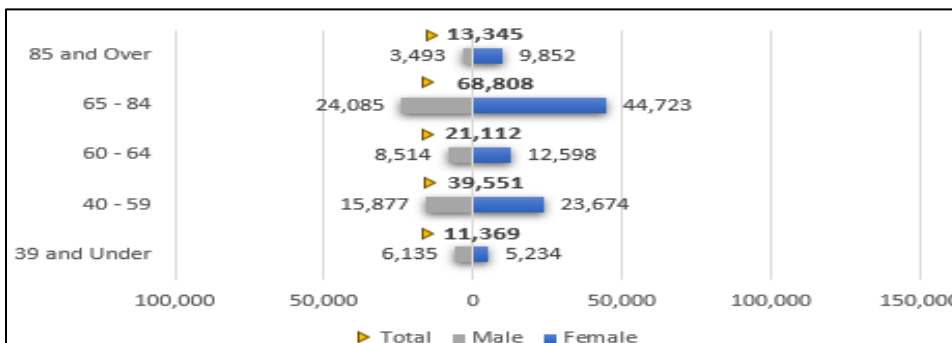
CHC by Gender and Age Group



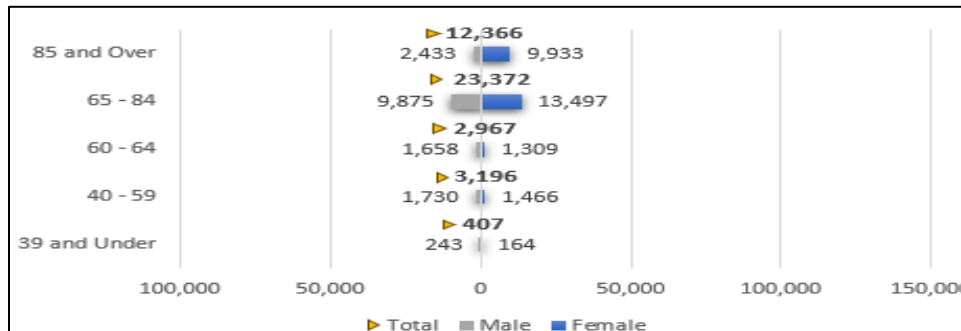
CHC-NFI by Gender and Age Group



CHC-HCBS by Gender and Age Group



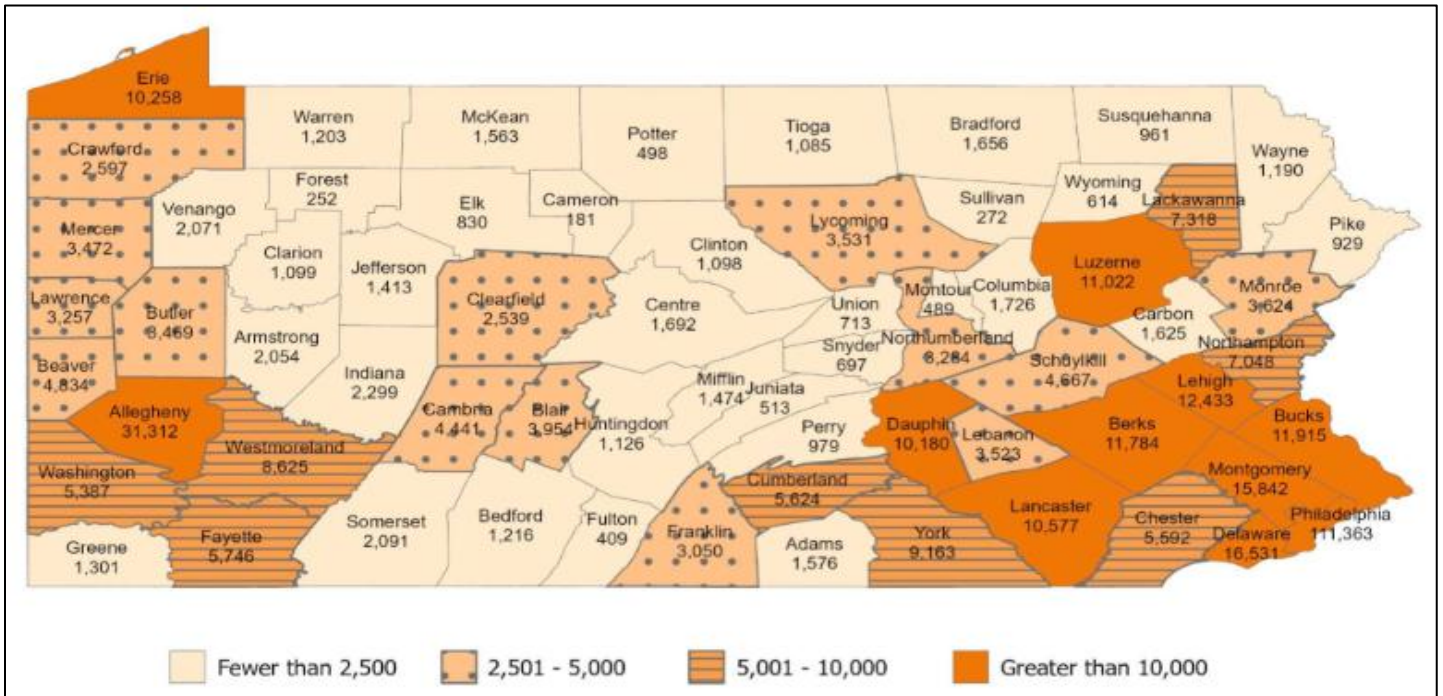
CHC-LTC by Gender and Age Group



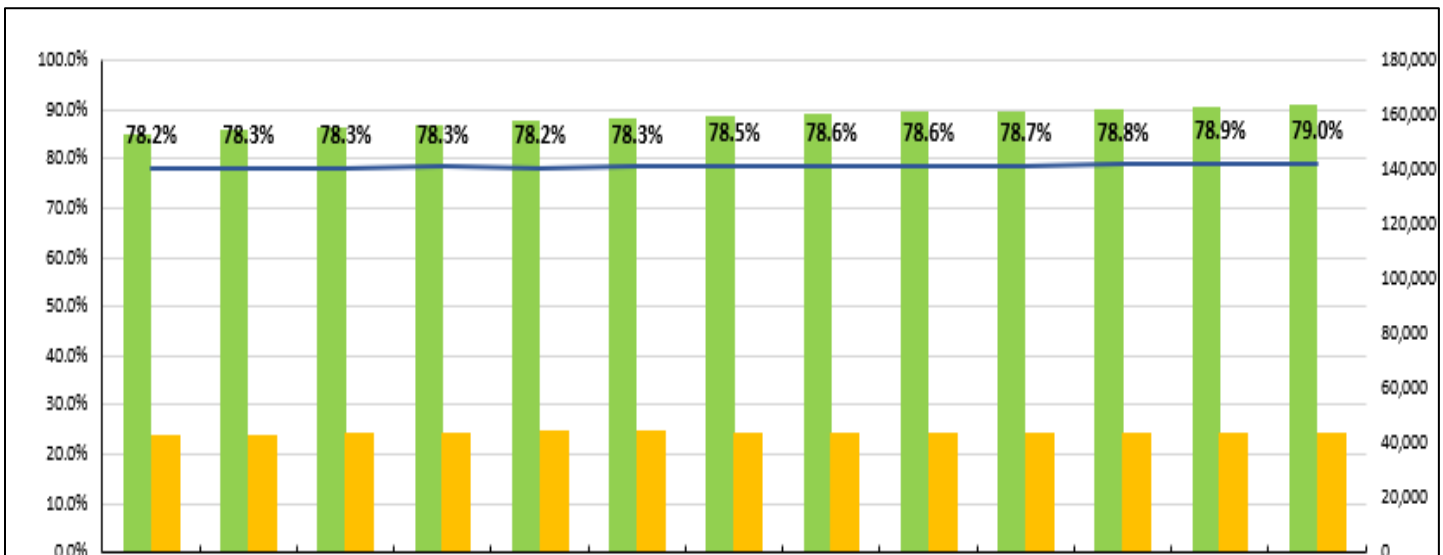

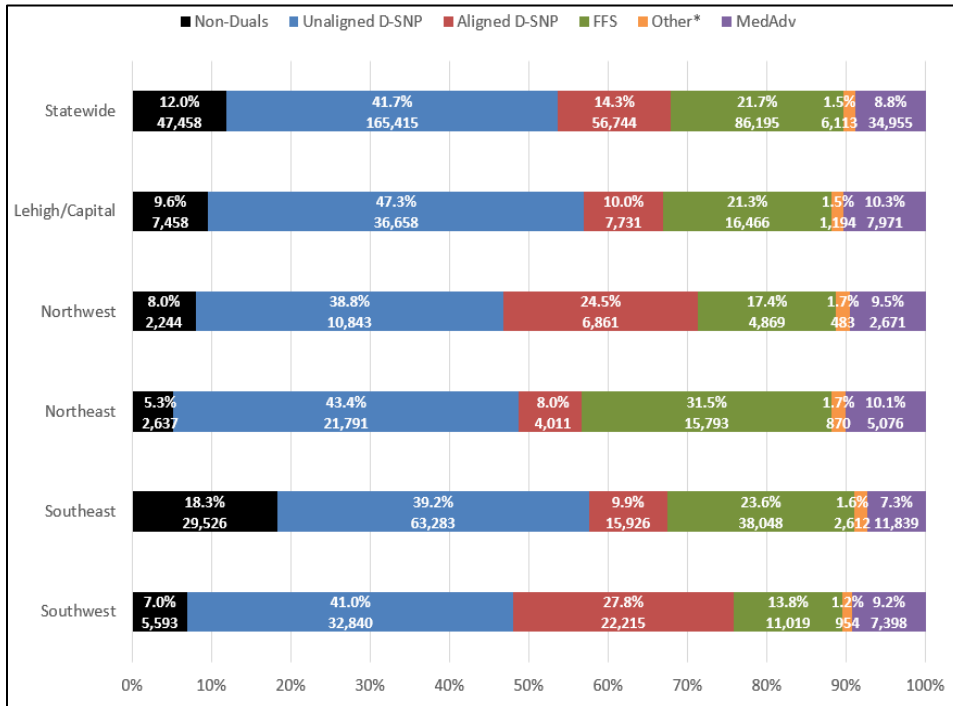

Summary:

In May, the statewide percentage of non-duals increased from 11.9% to 12.0%. The percentage of participants in aligned D-SNPs remained the same at 14.3%, and the percentage of participants in unaligned D-SNPs decreased from 41.8% to 41.7%. The percentage of participants in FFS Medicare remained the same at 21.7%. Other Med. Advantage increased from 8.7% to 8.8%.

Medicare Type by CHC Zone and Plan

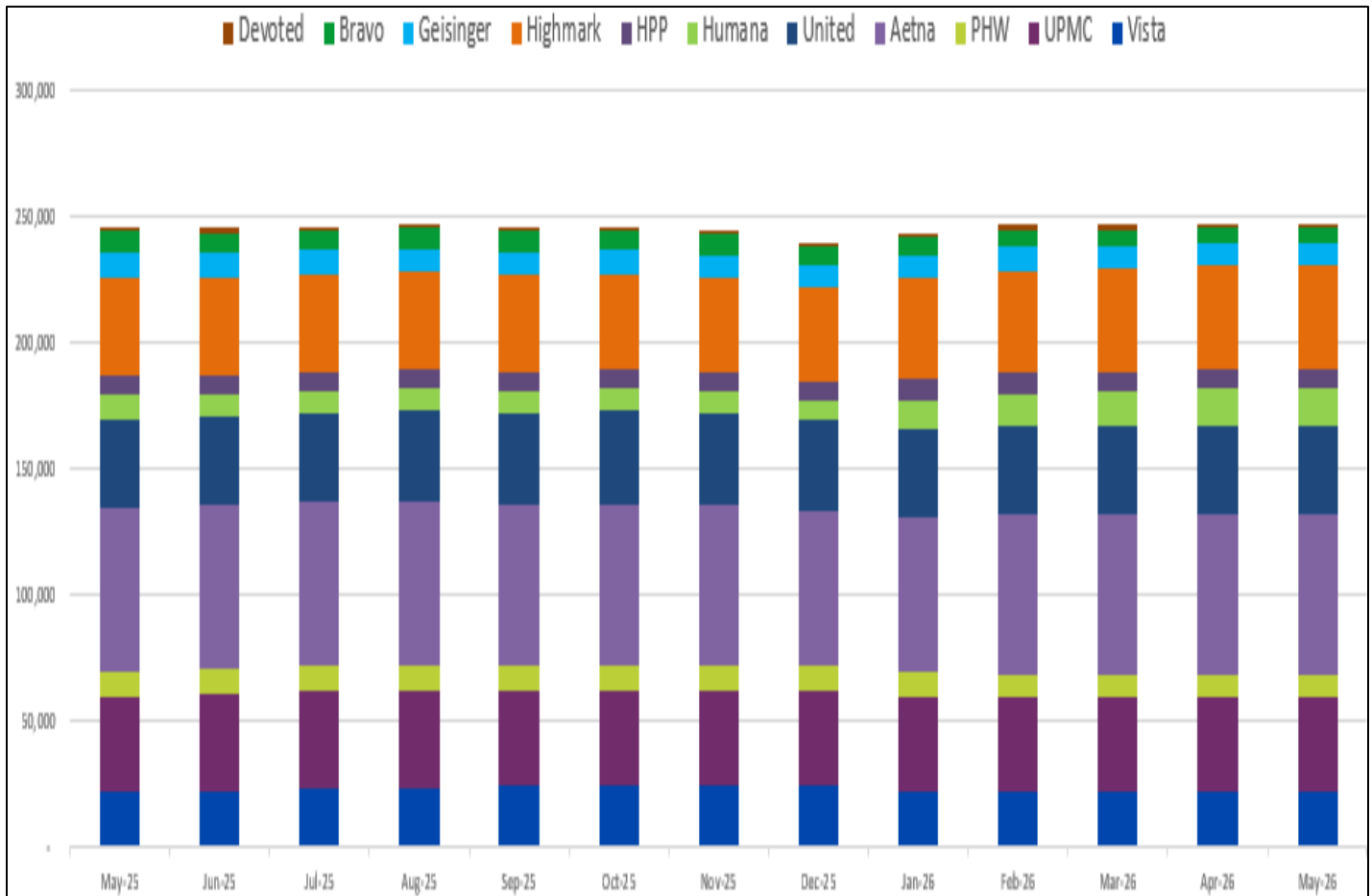

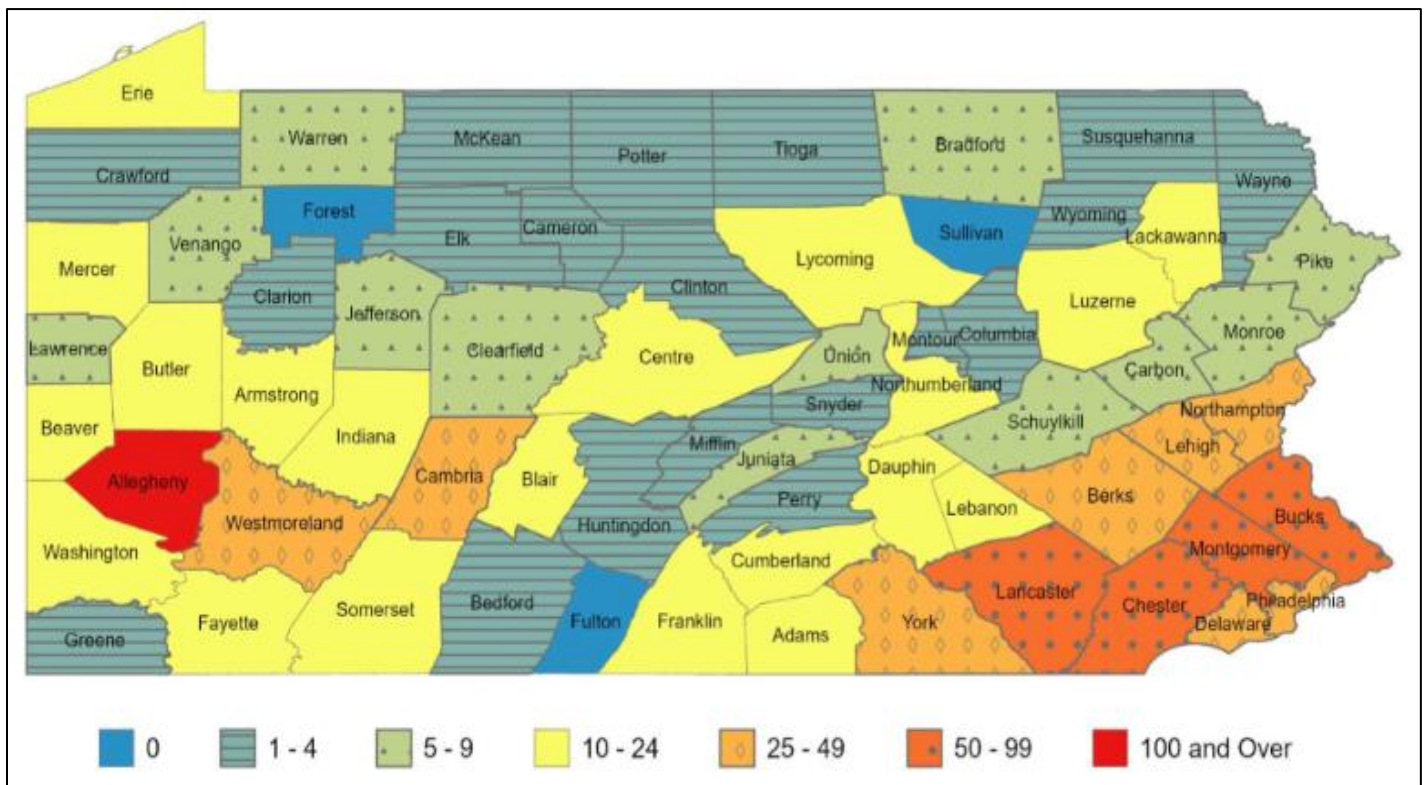
Number of Participant Choosing Participant Self-Direction*

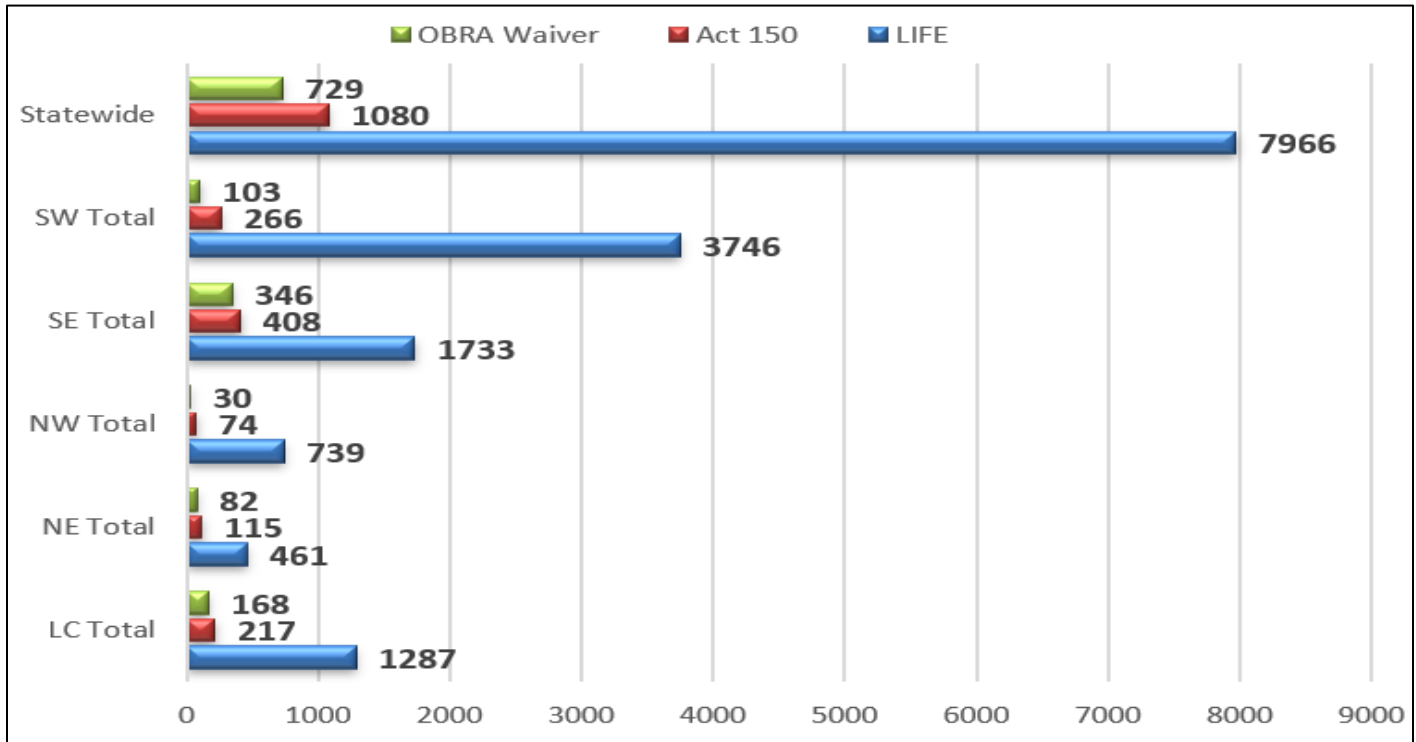

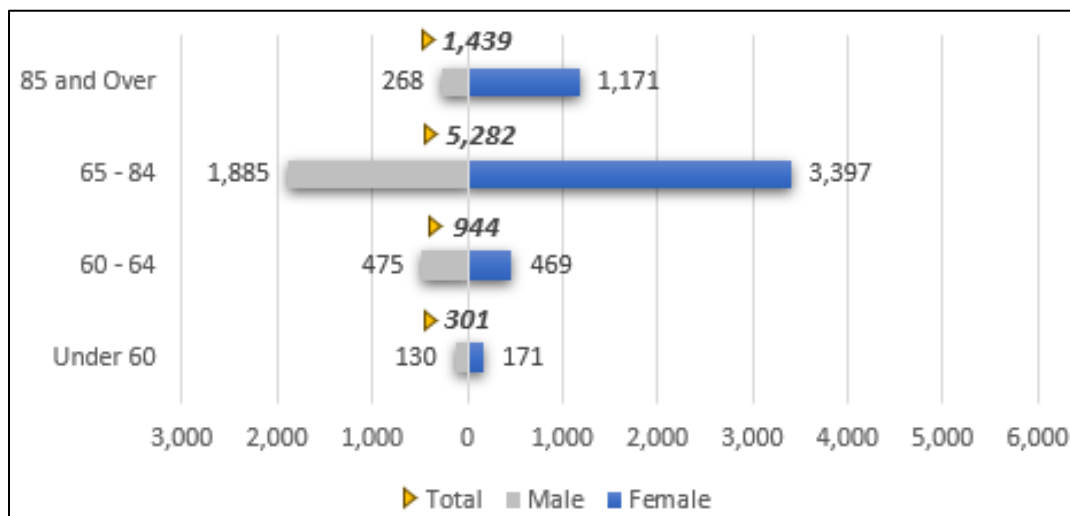
