








#### **CHC Market Share Chart**






#### CHC Enrollments by County\*

#### Statewide LTSS Population and HCBS Percentage






#### Medicare Type for All CHC Participants by Region\*\*



In April, the statewide percentage of non-duals remained the same at 9.2%. The percentage of participants in aligned D-SNPs decreased from 13.0% to 12.9%, and the percentage of participants in unaligned D-SNPs increased from 34.7% to 34.8%. The percentage of participants in FFS Medicare decreased from 30.6% to 30.3%. Other Medicare Advantage increased to 11.3%.


#### D-SNP Enrollments by Plan



### Number of Personal Care Homes and Assisted Living Facilities by County






#### Other OLTL Program Enrollment
