

CHC Statewide Monthly Enrollments by MCO




Total CHC enrollment as of September 2020 is 376,578 up from 374,058 in August.


CHC Monthly Enrollment by Zone and MCO



CHC Market Share Chart






The graphic below reflects the changes from August's market share by MCO to September's market share by MCO. All fluctuations are 0.5% or less.

CHC August to September Market Share Changes






The NFI population continues to account for the majority of the population at 62.2%. The percentage of HCBS participants increased to 26.0% of the population and the LTC population decreased 0.2% to 11.8% of the population from August.

*Note: If a participant is in a nursing facility and has a home outside of the nursing facility, the participant is counted in the county of the nursing facility


Statewide LTSS Population and HCBS Percentage



In September, the statewide percentage of non-duals remained at 8.3%. The percentage of participants in aligned D-SNPs increased by 0.2%, and the percentage of participants in FFS Medicare decreased by 0.3%. Changes in other Medicare types were less than 0.1%




