

## Hospice & Palliative Care in the Personal Care Home

This training provides an in-depth overview of end-of-life care principles within personal care home settings. Participants will explore the distinctions between hospice and palliative care, communication strategies, regulatory requirements, and best practices for supporting residents and families through the dying process. Emphasis is placed on compassionate care, ethical considerations, team collaboration, and maintaining dignity and comfort at the end of life.

This 6-hour hybrid training includes a 3-hour prerequisite that must be completed online before attending the live, virtual 3-hour session.
