

Durable Medical Equipment

Durable Medical Equipment (DME) is the term used for a device that a person uses repeatedly over a long time and is prescribed by a healthcare professional. This training will review the various types of DME that may be utilized in licensed facilities. It will also discuss what policies and procedures should be implemented, reviewed, or revised related to DME storage, safety, and regulations. It will provide industry best practices regarding referrals and training for staff. The training will include an opportunity for learners to familiarize themselves with the safe usage of resident equipment and how to prepare for using DME during emergencies. This 6-hour hybrid training includes a 3-hour prerequisite, to be completed online **prior** to attending the live, virtual 3-hour session.
