

**APPENDIX H-5 – Regulations for a New Child Care Center – School Age Program
Operating in a School Building**

A facility in which care is provided exclusively to school-age children shall comply only with the sections specified in 55 Pa. Code §3270.241, relating to requirements specific to school-age programs. The operator of a school-age child day care facility located in a public or private school building, a building used by an intermediate unit, or an area career technology center which meets the physical site requirements acceptable to the Department of Education is exempt from DHS physical site requirements (see §3270.241(b)(5)(i)). The operator must demonstrate compliance with the requirements outlined below to receive an initial provisional certificate of compliance:

§3270.18	Liability insurance
§3270.27	Emergency plan
§3270.31(a), (b) and (c)	Age and training
§3270.32(a)	Suitability of persons in the facility
§3270.33(d)	General requirements for facility persons
§3270.34	Director qualifications and responsibilities
§3270.35	Group supervisor qualifications and responsibilities
§3270.36	Assistant group supervisor qualifications and responsibilities
§3270.192	Content of records
§3270.241(c) (1), (2) and (3)	Requirements specific to a school age program

If a violation of one of the above requirements is cited as a result of an initial inspection, the operator will be provided an opportunity to submit an acceptable plan to correct the violation. No provisional certificate of compliance will be recommended until compliance with all of the above requirements is verified by a DHS representative.

If a violation is cited regarding a regulatory requirement other than one of those outlined above, the operator must submit an acceptable plan of correction in order for a provisional certificate of compliance to be recommended.
