OLTL HCBS Rate Study Goals

OLTL is partnering with Mercer Government Human Services Consulting (Mercer), part of Mercer Health & Benefits LLC, to perform an HCBS rate study on select service categories with the following goals:

- 1. Ensure existing fee schedule rates are adequate and appropriate by building market-based provider rates as a benchmark
- 2. Estimate fiscal impact of associated rate range recommendations in cases where there are gaps compared to existing rates
- **3. Engage key stakeholders** in the process to ensure that results and assumptions are reasonable



Mercer will evaluate the following services categories in this rate study:

- 1. Adult Day
- 2. Residential Habilitation (Res Hab)
- 3. Structured Day Habilitation (Structured Day Hab)
- 4. Employment and Training Services (Employment)
- 5. Personal Assistance Services (PAS)
 - 1. Participant Directed Services (PDS)
 - 2. Agency

Steps Completed To Date



Research and Comparisons

- ✓ Reviewed service definitions, applicable legislation, and stakeholder feedback
- ✓ Developed comparisons to similar services within Office of Developmental Programs fee schedules
- ✓ Identified other State Medicaid programs for comparison analysis

Analysis and Modeling


- ✓ Gathered and analyzed publicly available data on wages, benefits, and other service-related assumptions
- ✓ Began modeling of benchmark rate ranges using Mercer's proprietary rate models while awaiting provider survey results to validate assumptions

Provider Survey


- ✓ Developed and distributed provider survey to inform benchmark rate range development
- ✓ Received and adopted feedback from interested parties to incorporate into the provider survey through LTSS Committee, provider meeting, and email communication

Next Steps

- □ Analyze survey results by service type to inform rate development
- ☐ Finalize modeling of benchmark rate ranges ensuring reasonability by comparing assumptions to provider survey results
- ☐ Develop fiscal impact estimates using rate ranges calculated
- ☐ Present rate study results to OLTL including survey summaries, rate ranges, and estimated fiscal impact
