Streamline Your Revalidation Submission

The federal regulation at 42 CFR 455.414 requires that State Medicaid Agencies revalidate the enrollment of all providers, regardless of provider type, at least every 5 years.

Due to an anticipated increase in Provider Revalidation Applications later this year, providers are encouraged to verify their revalidation due dates and submit applications early to prevent processing delays.

The Pennsylvania Medicaid Provider Portal allows providers to revalidate up to ten (10) service locations in a single application using the multiple revalidation feature. This helps to reduce processing time and administrative burden.
