




Life Expectancy: US vs. comparable countries






Life expectancy varies greatly across PA



Average life expectancy in PA = 76.9 years (2020-22)




State Health Assessment (SHA) provides picture of health across PA





Regional Health Indicators


Life expectancy in this region varies by 4 years






Differences by census tract more pronounced

Range of LE by census tract: 70–88 years






Cancer deaths per 100,000 people, 2019–2023*






Cardiovascular deaths per 100,000 people, 2019–2023*






Cerebrovascular deaths per 100,000 people, 2019–2023*






Cigarette smoking prevalence among adults, 2022






Obesity prevalence among adults, 2022






Diabetes prevalence among adults, 2022






Drug overdose deaths per 10,000 people, 2024



PA average: 2.5 deaths per 10,000 people




Suicides per 100,000 people, 2018–2022*






Infant deaths per 1,000 live births, 2019–2023






Prenatal care in 1st trimester, 2019–2023






Birth statistics, 2019–2023






Resident to primary care provider ratio, 2022






Resident to behavioral health provider ratio, 2025










Addressing rural health needs in PA

Roles of DOH

- Study the distribution and causes of disease (epidemiology)
- Educate the public on healthy behaviors and disease prevention
- Prevent and respond to outbreaks and health emergencies
- Provide safety net clinical services (e.g., state health centers)
- Assure safe delivery of quality health care (e.g., regulations)
- Coordinate emergency medical services (EMS)
- Provide Vital Records services (birth, death and fetal)
- Direct Medical Marijuana Program
