

Card Skimmer

A traditional card skimmer is placed over the card reader at a POS system, ATM, or fuel pump terminal. When the customer pays with a card by placing it into the card reader, the card information is scanned and used to steal the victim's funds.



Hidden Camera


Small, concealed cameras are usually installed in conjunction with a card skimmer in order to capture customers entering their PIN. Cameras are typically installed on the front of an ATM, fuel pump terminal, or somewhere nearby like a pole or light fixture.



Keypad Overlay

A fairly new technology that records keystrokes and is used to capture customer PINs.
