Make sure you keep receiving important information

Due to changes in federal policy, you might need to report work, education, training, and/or volunteer hours to the Pennsylvania Department of Human Services (DHS) in order to receive SNAP benefits. DHS' goal is to make sure Pennsylvanians have the information they need to stay connected to life-sustaining nutrition assistance to help them feed themselves and their families.
