Types of One-Stop Service Delivery Locations





A Comparison of One-Stop Centers/Sites

A physical location where customers can access programs, services, and activities of all required one-stop partners.

Comprehensive Site



Local workforce delivery service locations where one or more partners make workforce employment and training programs, services, and activities available.

Affiliated Site



An access point, with a connection to a comprehensive site, where one or more partners make workforce employment and training programs, services, and activities available.

Access to Required Partner Services

20 CFR § 678.305(d)





A **Comprehensive One-Stop Center must** provide:

- ✓ **Access** to career services;
- ✓ **Access** to training services;
- ✓ **Access** to any employment and training activities carried out under sec. 134(d) of WIOA;
- ✓ **Access** to programs and activities carried out by one-stop partners listed in 20 CFR §§ 678.400 through 678.410; and
- ✓ Workforce and labor market information.

20 CFR § 678.305(b)





“Access” to each partner program means:

- Having a program staff member physically present at the one-stop center;
- Having a staff member from a different partner program physically present at the one-stop center appropriately trained to provide information to customers about the programs, services, and activities available through partner programs; or
- Making available a direct linkage through technology to program staff who can provide meaningful information or services.





Direct Linkage Explained:

A “direct linkage” means providing direct connection at the one-stop center, within a reasonable time, by phone or through a real-time Web-based communication to a program staff member who can provide program information or services to the customer.

CUSTOMER

A “direct linkage” cannot exclusively be providing a phone number or computer website or providing information, pamphlets, or materials.



Direct linkage provides the opportunity to use the CWDS referral system to document and follow-up with customer referrals.

YouthBuild, HUD, and Second Chance Act Partners

- **YouthBuild** – Can be an official YouthBuild USA program or [an organization receiving YouthBuild funds](#). For more information on the seven YouthBuild USA Affiliates in PA, please go to the [Youth Build program map](#) and search Pennsylvania.
- **HUD** – There are three grants HUD has identified for employment and training activities: the [Jobs Plus Initiative \(JPI\)](#) grant, the [Family Self-Sufficiency \(FSS\)](#) grant, and the [Resident Opportunities and Self-Sufficiency \(ROSS\)](#) grant. HUD does not compel local housing authorities to apply for grants.
- **Second Chance Act** – There are both statewide and local providers of programs funded through the Second Chance Act. A comprehensive list can be found via the [National Re-entry Resource Center](#). On the map, choose PA. Download the PDF and view programs that are currently funded.
