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Pennsylvania Veterans Fast Facts

Pennsylvania had 275,615 veterans between the ages of 18 and 64 in 2023, which was 3.6 percent of the comparable population in the state. Of these, 211,501 were in the labor force, for a participation rate of 76.7 percent. In comparison, Pennsylvania's non-veteran labor force participation rate for those aged 18 to 64 was 78.7 percent. There were 5,601 unemployed veterans in 2023, for an unemployment rate of 2.6 percent. Pennsylvania's non-veteran unemployment rate was 4.3 percent. (Table 1)

The five counties with the highest percentage of veterans (2023 ACS 1-Year Estimates) were: Blair (7.2%); Mercer (7.1%); Northumberland (6.9%); Crawford (6.5%); and, Carbon (6.4%). (Table 1)

The five counties with the highest veteran unemployment rates (2023 ACS 1-Year Estimates) were: Blair (8.7%); Schuylkill (7.2%); Butler (7.0%); Indiana (6.6%); and, York (5.5%). Adams (0.0%), Beaver (0.0%), Clearfield (0.0%), Crawford (0.0%), Franklin (0.0%), Lawrence (0.0%), and Monroe (0.0%) counties had the lowest veteran unemployment rates. (Table 1)

The five counties with the highest veteran labor force participation rates (2023 ACS 1-Year Estimates) were: Carbon (89.4%); Washington (89.3%); Berks (87.7%); Columbia (87.3%); and, Franklin (87.0%).

Pennsylvania veterans in 2023 age 18 and above were primarily from one of the following groups: Male; White; 75 years old and over; High School Graduates (includes equivalency); and, Vietnam Era, no Korean War, no World War II period of service. (Tables 2 and 3)

In the month of November 2024, there were 166 Pennsylvania veterans claiming Unemployment Compensation benefits (UCX program). The UCX program does not account for all the veterans who were receiving UC benefits – it only accounts for veterans who were recently discharged from the military. Allegheny (18) and Philadelphia (17) counties had the highest number of participants in the UCX program. Claimant counts less than 3 have been suppressed, unless there were 0, which is reported. (Table 4)

The top three active enlisted Military Occupational Classifications (MOS) were: Engineering, Science, and Technical (16.4%); Vehicle and Machinery Mechanic (14.2%); and, Combat Specialty (14.1%). The top three active officer Military Occupational Classifications were: Engineering, Science, and Technical (24.3%); Transportation and Material Handling (24.1%); and, Combat Specialty (16.2%). (Table 5)

Compared to the United States, in 2023, Pennsylvania ranked 8th highest in the number of veterans (275,615) and 38th in the percent of its population (3.6%) who were veterans. Alaska ranked first (7.9%), followed by Virginia (7.2%) and Montana (6.3%). (Table 6)

The United States unemployment rate for veterans in 2023 was 3.4 percent, eight-tenths of a percentage point higher than Pennsylvania's rate (2.6%). Pennsylvania's unemployment rate for veterans was the 15th lowest in the nation. (Table 6)

The United States labor force participation rate for veterans in 2023 was 77.5 percent, nine-tenths of a percentage point higher than Pennsylvania's rate (76.7%). Pennsylvania's labor force participation rate for veterans was 28th highest in the nation. (Table 6)

The source of most of the data in this report is from the U.S. Census Bureau's American Community Survey. The survey provides veterans county estimates in one and five year formats. In Pennsylvania, 40 counties had large enough sample sizes to be included in the one-year survey (Table 1) and all counties (67) for the five-year survey. (Table 7)
