

The Department can post detailed information regarding each individual or business who is currently registered and able to perform secondhand disinfection services on its Bedding and Upholstery website (www.dli.pa.gov/bedding). This is posted to aid individuals and companies, in the public and private sector, who are looking to obtain the services of a Disinfection permit holder to perform the disinfection of their secondhand bedding or upholstered furniture products. All secondhand bedding and upholstered furniture articles must be disinfected using an approved disinfectant (currently Steri-Fab or Microban with tracer) and must have attached to them a yellow law label. The label must state the registration and permit number of the individual/business that performed the disinfecting.
