

## ACTIVE SEARCH FOR WORK WAIVER FORM

Do not complete this request if you are already exempt by law from performing work searches, such as if you have a return to work date in writing from your employer. For a complete list of exemptions, visit <a href="www.uc.pa.gov">www.uc.pa.gov</a>.

In order to be eligible to receive unemployment compensation (UC) benefits, Section 401(b) of the Pennsylvania Unemployment Compensation Law (UC Law) requires each claimant to make an active search for work during each week for which benefits are claimed. However, the UC law allows the Department of Labor & Industry to waive or alter the active search for work requirements for a claimant if the secretary determines that compliance with such requirements would be oppressive or would be inconsistent with the purposes of the UC law.

You may use this form to request the department to waive or alter the active search-for-work requirements for you. Enter your name and Social Security number below and provide detailed information explaining why your compliance with these requirements would be oppressive or inconsistent with the purposes of the UC law. IMPORTANT: In order to be eligible for UC benefits, a claimant must be able to work and available for suitable work. If you request a waiver or alteration of the active search-for-work requirements for reasons that render you unable to
