Non-binary Gender Designation Option on Driver Licenses, ID Cards

PennDOT now offers its customers a non-binary gender option for its driver licenses and photo identification cards.

Gender designation options on Pennsylvania driver's licenses and photo ID cards are "M" (male), "F" (female) or "X" (non-binary). Customers who wish to change their gender designation should fill out Form DL-32, "Request for Gender Change on Driver's License/Identification Card," and bring it to any PennDOT Driver License Center to complete the process. This process does not require the signoff by a medical or social service provider.

A gender designation change must be completed in person at a PennDOT Driver License Center. Driver License Center locations can be found by clicking on "Find a Location" at www.dmv.pa.gov.

The gender designation change is offered free-of-charge; however, applicable duplicate fees will apply to customers who wish to obtain a duplicate license or photo ID card reflecting the change in designation. If you have a commercial driver's license or a REAL ID product, a gender designation change is considered a "material change," and you must get a duplicate product and pay applicable duplicate fees.
