Product Expiration Dates for the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

Effective September 30, 2020, the following products' expiration dates were extended for Pennsylvania residents in response to statewide COVID-19 mitigation efforts:

- The expiration date for a commercial learner's permit scheduled to expire from March 16, 2020, through November 29, 2020, was extended through November 29, 2020.
- The expiration date for commercial driver licenses scheduled to expire from March 16, 2020, through November 29, 2020, was extended through November 29, 2020.
- The expiration date of a Hazardous Materials Endorsement (HME) for an individual who is a Pennsylvania-licensed commercial driver's license holder and who held a valid, unexpired HME with a determination of no security threat on or after March 6, 2020, was extended until October 29, 2020.

Expiration extension deadlines on non-commercial driver license, photo identification cards, learner's permits and camera cards expired on August 31.
