NY Verifi Program

In 2018, New York State Department of Motor Vehicles announced the implementation of the Vehicle Electronic Reassignment and Integrated Facility Inventory (VERIFI) system. VERIFI allows New York State licensed automobile dealers to use VERIFI to record their retail and wholesale transfers online using the electronic Certificate of Sale (eMV-50).

Vehicles from or passing through New York may contain an eMV-50 Certificate of Sale receipt within the chain of ownership documents. This document is no different than an odometer disclosure statement, but it is no longer recorded on secure paper like it has been in the past. If an agent questions the authenticity of the document or it appears altered, you must access a public website (https://www.verifiny.com/check) by entering the eMV-50 number printed on the receipt or by entering the vehicle identification number (VIN), Model Year and Make. If agents still feel that the document is guestionable, they should forward the document and work to the PennDOT's Risk Management Office for review.

Attached is an example of the type of documentation that may be submitted using notarization for an individual who is remotely located.
