ACT 89 - Consumer Price Index (CPI) Fee Adjustments Affecting Dealer Registrations

Act 89, which became law on November 25, 2013, biennially amends many sections of Title 75. Act 89 represents an investment in Pennsylvania's future: increasing public safety, driving commerce, creating jobs, and providing reliable funding for our transportation needs without leaving the bill to our future generations.

Based on the 2021 CPI, effective July 1, 2021, the act amends the following sections of the Vehicle Code:

- Section 1926(a): The annual Dealer and Miscellaneous Motor Vehicle Business Dealer registration fees adjust from \$56 to \$58.
- Section 1926(b): The Motorcycle Dealer registration fees adjust from \$28 to \$29.
- Section 1926(c): The Motor-Driven Cycle and Moped Dealer registration fees adjust from \$15 to \$16

The new fees will appear on renewal notices sent to customers for the above registrations that have a current expiration date of July 2021 or later. PennDOT will begin accepting the new fee on May 29, 2021, for renewals listed above that expire July 2021 or later.
