New York Form MV-913

New York State Department of Motor Vehicles has recently implemented a new form, Form MV-913, "Title or Lien Status Report." This form was implemented as part of an upgrade to their web-based "Check Title or Lien Status" transactions. This form can be used to show proof that a lien has been satisfied. When this form is presented with the original NY title, the date referenced on the form should match the title issue date on the NY title. With this update, motorists, dealers, and other jurisdictions will be able to visit their website at www.dmv.ny.gov/titlestat and print a Form MV-913, or simply confirm the authenticity of a form being presented. When Agents are presented with Form MV-913, they must go to the website and validate the MV-913 and print the validation from the website showing that it matches the MV-913 and submit that with the rest of their documentation. Additionally, this should be done on the same day as the DLDV check to show the dates match and the MV-913 was verified.

The MV-913 is a true copy of an electronic record on file at the New York State Department of Motor Vehicles in Albany, New York. All MV-913's are date and time stamped so that the user can confirm the information displayed in the document is current as of the time and date that are indicated by the form.

Only active liens are shown on the form. Any lien printed on a New York Certificate of Title issued prior to the print date that is listed on the MV-913, has been released electronically. A separate lien release is not required as evidence that the lien had been satisfied.
