New Special Organization Registration Plates

PennDOT began accepting applications for the following newly designed special organization registration plates. The newly designed registration plates reflect the "Pennsylvania Family of Plate" colors that are blue, white, and yellow. The organization's name is printed at the bottom of the plate. The organization's logo appears in an approximate 3"x3" canvas area on the left side of the plate using graphic printing that offers color and intricate detail.

The following plates are now available for order:



• Geneva College: The plate number consists of a two-character stacked configuration GC followed by five numbers starting with the number "0." Applicants must obtain form MV-904SP, "Application for Special Organization Registration

Plate," from the organization and pay any applicable fees, including a \$32 fee to the department for processing. Only those applications signed by Beckie Cottage, may be processed.



• Pittsburgh Vintage Grand Prix: The plate number consists of a two-character stacked configuration GP followed by five numbers starting with the number "0." Applicants must obtain form MV-904SP, "Application for Special Organization

Registration Plate," from the organization and pay any applicable fees, including a \$32 fee to the department for processing. Only those applications signed by Scott Rupert, may be processed.



 NicNac Charities: The plate number consists of a two-character stacked configuration NN followed by five numbers starting with the number "0." Applicants must obtain form MV-904SP, "Application for Special Organization Registration

Plate," from the organization and pay any applicable fees, including a \$32 fee to the department for processing. Only those applications signed by Nicholas Birosik, may be processed.



 American Fire Company #1: The plate number consists of a two-character stacked configuration AF preceded by five numbers starting with the number "4." Applicants must obtain form MV-904SP, "Application for Special Organization

Registration Plate," from the organization and pay any applicable fees, including a \$32 fee to the department for processing. Only those applications signed by Zachary Gilbert, may be processed.



• NAWCC, Inc.: The plate number consists of a two-character stacked configuration WC preceded by five numbers starting with the number "1." Applicants must obtain form MV-904SP, "Application for Special Organization

Registration Plate," from the organization and pay any applicable fees, including a \$32 fee to the department for processing. Only those applications signed by Alexander Simpkins, may be processed.
