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Act 60 of 2024 – Consumer Price Index (CPI) Fee Adjustments Affecting Retired Status Annual Income

Act 60 of 2024, introduced an annual CPI adjustment to the income threshold for qualifying for the retired status registration processing fee. Based on the 2025 CPI, effective January 1, 2026, the act amends the following section of the Vehicle Code:

- Section 1901 1901 (C) (II), relating to vehicle owner that qualify for retired status by updating the annual income from \$29,906 to \$30,778, which becomes effective January 1, 2026. The new income threshold will be subject to an annual CPI adjustment.

Please note, this change is effective for registrations that expire in January 2026 and later. You will begin seeing the new income threshold on the registration renewal notices for January, which will be mailed beginning in October.
