SPECIAL ORGANIZATION REGISTRATION PLATES

PennDOT began accepting applications for the following newly designed special organization registration plates. The newly designed registration plates showcase Pennsylvania as the birthplace of America and features the Liberty Bell. The organization's name is printed at the bottom of the plate. The organization's logo appears in an approximate 3" X 3" canvas area on the left side of the plate using graphic printing that offers color and intricate detail.

The following plates are now available to be ordered:



dlivrd Difference: The plate configuration will continue to consist of the two-character stacked designation of "DD," followed by five numbers starting with the number two "2." Applicants must obtain form MV-904SP, "Application for Special Organization Registration Plate," from the

organization and pay any applicable fees, including the required fee to the department for processing. Only those Applications signed by Bradley McCallister may be processed.



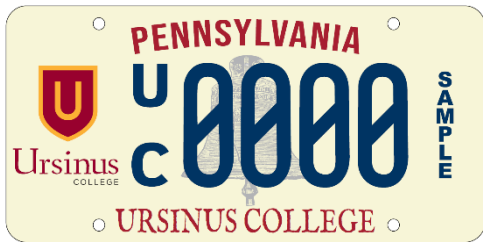
Middletown Vol. Fire Dept.: The plate configuration will continue to consist of the two-character stacked designation of "MV," followed by five numbers starting with the number zero "0." Applicants must obtain form MV-904SP, "Application for Special Organization Registration Plate," from the

organization and pay any applicable fees, including the required fee to the department for processing. Only those Applications signed by Justin Gilday may be processed.

organization and pay any applicable fees, including the required fee to the department for processing. Only those Applications signed by David Eberle may be processed.



Wilkes University: The plate configuration will continue to consist of the two-character stacked designation of "WU," followed by five numbers starting with the number two "2." Applicants must obtain form MV-904SP, "Application for Special Organization Registration Plate," from the

organization and pay any applicable fees, including the required fee to the department for processing. Only those Applications signed by Julia Bucholtz may be processed.



United Brotherhood of Carpenters: The plate configuration will continue to consist of the two-character stacked designation of "CU," followed by five numbers starting with the number zero "0." Applicants must obtain form MV-904SP, "Application for Special Organization Registration

Plate," from the organization and pay any applicable fees, including the required fee to the department for processing. Only those Applications signed by Alissa Kline may be processed.



Pennsylvania Society of Physician Associates:

The plate configuration will continue to consist of the two-character stacked designation of "PP," preceded by five numbers starting with the number three "3." Applicants must obtain form MV-904SP, "Application for Special Organization Registration

Plate," from the organization and pay any applicable fees, including the required fee to the department for processing. Only those Applications signed by Steph Benko may be processed.



Pennsylvania Masons: The plate configuration will continue to consist of the two-character stacked designation of "MB," followed by five numbers starting with the number zero "0." Applicants must obtain form MV-904SP, "Application for Special Organization Registration Plate," from the

organization and pay any applicable fees, including the required fee to the department for processing. Only those Applications signed by Mark Haines may be processed.



National Wild Turkey Federation: The plate configuration will continue to consist of the two-character stacked designation of "WT," followed by five numbers starting with the number zero "0." Applicants must obtain form MV-904SP, "Application for Special Organization Registration

Plate," from the organization and pay any applicable fees, including the required fee to the department for processing. Only those Applications signed by Brendan Oosterkamp may be processed.
