## Adjustment of Minimum Waiver Expenditure for Emission Inspection

Effective September 1, 2023, the minimum waiver expenditure for an emission inspection will increase to \$450. Additionally, the minimum waiver expenditure will be adjusted annually thereafter in accordance with 67 Pa. Code § 177.282.

Please note that this change will be made to the training material and available on our website beginning September 1, 2023. Any existing printed material will no longer be current after the change, and as such should not be used.

Schools should begin educating new emission inspectors about this upcoming September 1, 2023 change during any classes conducted from this point forward.
