Dolores Thomas, notary commission ID. 1261019 of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, agreed to not apply for reappointment as a notary public for four years because she performed a notarial act without being properly appointed and commissioned; and accepted Accelerated Rehabilitative Disposition for felonies and/or offenses involving fraud, dishonesty, or deceit.
