Continuing Education Information for Chiropractors

One of the requirements for chiropractic license renewal is completion of at least **twenty-four hours of Board-approved** continuing education in each biennial renewal period. Chiropractic licenses expire on September 1st of even-numbered years.

New licensees are exempt from continuing education requirements for their first renewal period only.

Credits will only be accepted for courses approved by the Pennsylvania Board. Please note that it is your responsibility to verify the PA Board Approval Number with the sponsor PRIOR TO TAKING THE COURSE.

Be sure to obtain official Certificates of Attendance from the sponsor of the course which indicate: the name of the sponsor, name of attendee, title and date of the course, number of clock hours, signature of person authenticating attendance, and the PA Board Approval number – (mandatory).

Licensees must keep official Certificates of Attendance for four years after the biennial expiration date, because the Board will conduct a random audit. **Do not send any Certificates of Attendance to the Board unless you are selected for the audit.**

PLEASE BE AWARE THAT FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS MAY RESULT IN DISCIPLINARY ACTION AGAINST YOUR PENNSYLVANIA LICENSE, WHICH MAY ALSO BE REPORTED TO THE FEDERAL DISCIPLINARY DATA BANK.
