there were ongoing regulatory developments regarding
mobile salons and booth rentals, and Ms. Weidner
inquired whether any of those changes had been

4 officially passed.

Mr. Merten clarified that the topics in question pertain to bills introduced in the state assembly, not finalized regulatory changes. He confirmed that several bills related to the Cosmetology Board, including ones addressing mobile salons and booth rentals, have indeed been introduced. However, to his knowledge, none of these bills have been voted on or officially discussed yet.

14 Public Comment

15 [Mr. Realejo asked about the pilot program,
16 expressing his understanding that it was supposed to
17 be discussed during the current meeting.

Mr. Merten explained that the pilot program was enacted by the legislature, not the board, although the board administered it. He noted that the legislation includes a sunset provision that is set to expire in June, meaning the current semester is likely the last in which the program will be active. To his knowledge, there has been no new legislation introduced to extend the program, although

1 discussions have taken place. 2 Mr. Realejo responded by stating that many of his 3 schools were asking about the program and sought 4 clarification on whether he should inform them that 5 it likely would not be extended. 6 Mr. Merten advised that nothing could be stated 7 definitively at this point. He noted that the regulatory counsel, who could provide a clearer update, was not present at the meeting but would 10 attend the next meeting. He apologized for the counsel's absence.] 11 12 13 Public Comment
