[Laura Neal, Esquire, Board Counsel, informed everyone that the meeting of the State Board of Dentistry was being held in a hybrid format, both in person and by livestream teleconference, pursuant to Act 100 of 2021, which requires boards to use a virtual platform to conduct business when a public meeting is held.

19 [Jacqueline A. Wolfgang, Esquire, Regulatory Counsel,
20 provided a Status of Regulations Report for the
21 Board's review and information.]

23 Report of Board Counsel - Regulation 16A-4628
24 (general revisions)

25 [Jacqueline A. Wolfgang, Esquire, Regulatory Counsel,

1 referred to 16A-4628 regarding general revisions.

2 Mr. Rouse noted the Board adopted the proposed
3 annex and the preamble for 16A-4628 in 2024. He
4 mentioned the regulatory package was being prepared
5 but there was much discussion on a particular issue
6 that needed to be clarified in the annex, where it
7 needed to be in the general revisions before it moved
8 forward.

9 Mr. Rouse referred to the annex for 16A-4628
10 under examinations § 33.103(a), dentists, where
11 candidates for licensure shall pass the National
12 Board Dental Examination, written examination, and
13 all sections of the psychomotor, hand skills dental
14 clinical examination administered by one of the
15 following administering agencies. He asked whether
16 the psychomotor, hand skills language is acceptable
17 for the dental clinical examination. Board members
18 agreed with the language.

19 Mr. Rouse referred to the preamble, where it
20 states the Board further proposes to amend § 33.103(a)
21 to clarify that dentist candidates must complete all
22 sections of the psychomotor, hand skills dental
23 clinical examinations administered by one of the
24 approved administering agencies. He mentioned the
25 Board has always interpreted § 33.103(a) as requiring

1 dentist candidates to complete the sections of the
2 dental clinical examination that tests on psychomotor
3 skills, i.e., hand skills. The proposed
4 clarification, however, will ensure that dental
5 candidates are clear that they must complete all
6 sections of the dental clinical examination that
7 tests on hand skills, including the prosthodontics,
8 endodontics, periodontal, and restorative (anterior
9 and posterior) sections.

10 Dr. Funari suggested language to read, including
11 but not limited to prosthodontics, endodontics,
12 periodontics, and restorative in case the exam
13 changes in the future. He asked how this sets the
14 Board up moving forward in light of the recent court
15 case regarding a one-year general practice residency
16 (GPR) being a substitute for what they are trying to
17 institute and asked whether that now renders a GPR
18 null and void.

19 Mr. Rouse offered to look into that but did not
20 believe so concerning that particular case. He
21 stated it is a requirement for everyone, so everyone
22 is put on notice that the requirement they are
23 looking at is the dental clinical examination that is
24 the psychomotor, hand skills portion because they do
25 know that there are portions of the exam that are not

1 hand skills portions of the exam.

2 Mr. Rouse agreed with the language Dr. Funari
3 suggested, including but not limited to, in case the
4 exam changes for additional hand skills portions.

5 Dr. Arndt referred to the incident Dr. Funari
6 mentioned concerning residencies. He commented that
7 past case law can be one thing, but when someone
8 changes the law, it does not matter what the case law
9 was beforehand.

10 Mr. Rouse reminded everyone that there is a
11 difference between regulations and case law but
12 offered to have further discussion after he conducted
13 additional research.

14 Mr. Rouse stated the language, including but not
15 limited, would be added in case there are additional
16 sections that are hand skills related to the dental
17 clinical examination. He also referred to dental
18 hygienists, noting the Objective Structured Clinical
19 Examination (OSCE) is a component of the dental
20 hygiene clinical examination that is administered
21 along with the psychomotor clinical section of the
22 clinical exam.

23 Ms. Murray referred to general revisions asked
24 whether they should be inserting their successor for
25 it to read, CDCA-WREB-CITA or its successor.

1 Mr. Rouse agreed with Ms. Murray, noting the
2 basis of adding successor language is because the
3 administering agencies have been merging and
4 changing.]

4 Report of Board Counsel - Regulation 16A-4635

5 (licensure by endorsement)

6 [Jacqueline A. Wolfgang, Esquire, Senior Regulatory
7 Counsel, addressed 16A-4635 regarding licensure by
8 endorsement. She noted Act 41 and the regulation
9 provides a pathway to licensure for individuals who
10 have a license in another jurisdiction. She also
11 noted Act 41 assists in reducing unnecessary barriers
12 to licensure for individuals seeking to practice in
13 Pennsylvania.

14 Ms. Wolfgang mentioned the Board published a
15 notice of proposed rulemaking on July 20, 2024, which
16 was followed by a 30-day public comment period. She
17 noted the Board received one public comment from the
18 Pennsylvania Academy of General Dentistry supporting
19 the proposed regulation.

20 Ms. Wolfgang stated the Independent Regulatory
21 Review Commission (IRRC) did not have any objections,
22 comments, or recommendations to offer on the proposal
23 and further indicated that if the Board delivers the
24 regulation without revision that it will be deemed
25 approved by IRRC.

1 Ms. Wolfgang provided the final-form rulemaking
2 with no revisions for the Board's review and
3 consideration. She noted the annex is exactly the
4 same as when the Board approved it as proposed. She
5 stated the preamble is different and talks about the
6 comments received from the academy and IRRC.

7 Mr. Rouse noted there were no changes in how they
8 have been deliberating Act 41 requests, because it
9 goes through the issues of determining substantial
10 equivalency, determining competency, and looking at
11 disciplinary matters.

12 Ms. Wolfgang referred to § 33.103 regarding
13 examinations, noting that provision is specifically
14 referenced, and the changes would be referenced when
15 evaluating Act 41 applications.

16 Mr. Rouse mentioned that it would memorialize how
17 the Board reviews Act 41 applications.]
