5 Board on current regulations. 16A-4635, Licensure by

Endorsement Act 41, was approved by the Office of 6

7 Attorney General on July 10, 2025. The expected

publication date is July 26, 2025, and will become 8

9 effective at that time.

Ms. Murray asked if there had been any progress with the mobile van regulation. Ms. Neal stated there was no update at this time. Regulation 16A-4629 regarding mobile vans and regulation regarding general revisions were both being worked on. It is expected the regulatory analysis form for both will be submitted to Office of General Counsel Budget Policy Office late July or early August. Ms. Neal expected to update the Board indicating some movement on the regulations at the September meeting.

Dr. Arndt asked about updates for regulation 16A-4621, regarding anesthesia updates. Ms. Neal responded the package was still being drafted; however, she did not expect an update until at least the November meeting.
