3 Report of Board Counsel - Regulatory Report

4 [Laura Neal, Esquire, Board Counsel, updated the
5 Board on current regulations. 16A-4635, Licensure by
6 Endorsement Act 41, was approved by the Office of
7 Attorney General on July 10, 2025. The expected
8 publication date is July 26, 2025, and will become
9 effective at that time.

10 Ms. Murray asked if there had been any progress
11 with the mobile van regulation. Ms. Neal stated
12 there was no update at this time. Regulation 16A-
13 4629 regarding mobile vans and regulation regarding
14 general revisions were both being worked on. It is
15 expected the regulatory analysis form for both will
16 be submitted to Office of General Counsel Budget
17 Policy Office late July or early August. Ms. Neal
18 expected to update the Board indicating some movement
19 on the regulations at the September meeting.

20 Dr. Arndt asked about updates for regulation 16A-
21 4621, regarding anesthesia updates. Ms. Neal
22 responded the package was still being drafted;
23 however, she did not expect an update until at least
24 the November meeting.

4 create positive changes for the people of
