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To answer a question posed by public member, Amy Alcantara, Mr. Barrett stated that a letter would be sent to Ms. Alcantara outlining the steps to appeal the Board's determination, and that appeals are typically sent to both the physical and email addresses on file in PALS.

Ms. Alcantara asked for clarification on whether she needed to wait until the next Board meeting on September 25 to appeal; to which, it was noted that the appeal hearing would typically be scheduled separately based on availability, and not necessarily tied to a Board meeting.]
