In line with Governor Josh Shapiro's focus on anti-discrimination and digital literacy, educators can access these tools through the Standards-Aligned Portal (SAS) to promote student safety and well-being within their school community.

1. Holocaust, Genocide, and Human Rights Toolkit

Studying the Holocaust provides critical insights into key concepts like democracy, dictatorship, propaganda, collaboration, resistance, and genocide. To support this, a new toolkit provides educators with a range of resources, including videos, lesson plans, and classroom materials that can be adapted for both virtual and in-person learning

The PDE Disability Inclusive Curriculum Pilot Program aims to educate all K-12 students about the political, economic, and social contributions of individuals with disabilities by promoting the accurate and regular representation of disability in all aspects of school life.
