



2025 School-Based ACCESS Program Stakeholder Sessions

The Pennsylvania Department of Human Services (DHS) and the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) are announcing the schedule for stakeholder sessions. As you may know, PA received a grant from the federal government to support expansion of school-based health services beyond those contained in an IEP. To develop the best program and plan for expansion, we need as much stakeholder input as possible.

DHS and PDE want to hear from you! We will be holding in-person stakeholder sessions across seven different locations and dates. Attendance at these events is limited to 50 individuals per site to ensure that voices are heard and input is captured. Attendees will participate in small group discussions to respond to questions about the provision of health-related services in the school setting and to share the needs Local Education Agencies experience in providing these services.
