Common Education Data Standards (CEDS) Align is the online data dictionary used by the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) to store, maintain, and access all collected data elements. This document will guide you through accessing the system and running basic outputs for the PDE Data Dictionary.

## Accessing CEDS Align Data Dictionary

- 1. Go to <u>https://ceds.ed.gov/align.aspx</u>.
- 2. If you have a login and password, please enter it on this page. While it is not necessary to create an account to access CEDS Align, additional reports are available for account holders if they are assigned to a map as a Map Administrator or Authorized User.
  - a. To create an account, click on the 'Create an Account' link located at the top righthand corner of the page and fill in the requested information.
- 3. The 'Use' column contains two options: Explore Map Based Reports and Explore Element Based Reports. Please select one option.
  - a. Explore Map Based Reports This view will allow the user to view reports based on CEDS maps that have been shared with all users. The reports will display information about the elements in the map and will allow the user to drill down into the elements' details for more information. This will be the option selected by most users.
  - b. Explore Element Based Reports This report will allow the user to see maps that have been shared with all users that have alignments to the selected CEDS elements. This allows the user to see how other states have aligned the data elements to CEDS.
- 4. Accessing Explore Map Based Reports
  - a. Click on the Explore Map Based Reports Link.

b. Choose Domain – 'K12' and Affiliation Type – 'All' and click on 'Next'.

c. Enter a checkmark beside 'Pennsylvania' and click 'Next'. Multiple states may be selected to allow a comparison of maps from those available.

d. In the final step, expand the selection to see all maps then select the map you want to view. Multiple maps may be selected to see changes in data collection from year to year.

- e. Once the map is selected, click next to be directed to the report page. There are three reports available to users that are not logged in to CEDS.
  - i. Data Dictionary Only This report will show only the data elements listed for the selected state(s) in a straightforward form including the System Name, Database Name, Table Name and Element Name. Clicking on any of the headers will allow you to sort the map based on the header.
  - Data Dictionary + CEDS Info This report will show all the Data Dictionary information along with the CEDS alignment. CEDS information aligns data elements to federal standards, when available. Not all elements align to CEDS standards.
  - iii. CEDS Elements with No Alignment The report shows all CEDS elements that have not been aligned to the map.

5. The reports may be downloaded by clicking on the Options dropdown box on the top of the page and selecting Download Full Report.

## **Report Output and Data Descriptions**

Once you have produced the report on your screen, you have the option to drill down into the element details for more information or download the file in an Excel format to sort and filter the data elements. Each report produced will display data fields in the Data Dictionary either with or without the CEDS alignment depending on the report chosen. Below is a list of the columns contained in each report with a description of the column information.

#### **Data Dictionary Only Report**

This report will show only the data elements listed for the selected state(s) in a straightforward format including the System Name, Database Name, Table Name and Element Name.

This report has two tabs in the Excel output file; Data Dictionary and Individual Element Details.

Column Name	Description
Domain Topic	Information in this field directs the user to the CEDS element
	location within the Domain Entity Schema (DES).
CEDS Element	This field contains the name of the CEDS element.

SY1920 Pennsylvania	This fields contains the information regarding the state's data
Information	element (i.e. System Name, Database Name, Table Name, and
Management System	Element Name) associated with the chosen report.

CEDS Element Data Model ID	This is the version-specific CEDS identifier. Use this identifier when mapping to CEDS.
CEDS Element Global ID	The CEDS global ID is the numeric CEDS ID assigned to an element. This remains the same across all versions of CEDS.

### **Data Dictionary and CEDS Information Report**

This report will show all the Data Dictionary information with the CEDS information. CEDS information aligns data elements to federal standards, when available. Not all elements align to CEDS standards.

Column Name	Description
Map Name	This is the name given to the map by the state. Pennsylvania will have a map created for each collection year. For example, SY1920 Pennsylvania Information Management System (PIMS).
System Name	System name refers to the official collection system. Examples are PIMS, IC, PNPE.

## **CEDS Elements with No Alignment Report**

This report shows all CEDS elements, across all domains, that have not been aligned in the user's map.

Column Name	Description
Map Name	This is the name of the chosen map for the output report.
CEDS Element	The location of the element in CEDS.
