


Good Moral Character

- **Policy:** The Department of Education is required by law to only issue Pennsylvania certificates to applicants who possess good moral character (24 P.S. § 1209, 22 PA Code § 49.12).
- Action: Certifying officers (COs) evaluate the applicant's moral character based on their own knowledge and judgment.
- Example: COs could review the applicant's known history of criminal and professional behavior, including adherence to ethical standards.



Utilize Notes

- Tip: Ensure accurate dates for degree conferred, program attendance, and completion.
- Action: Utilize the notes section to address discrepancies or inconsistencies. Notes can look different based on CO.

Intern Protocol

- Tip: TIMS metrics do not align with intern affirmations.
- Action: PDE recommends the following protocol
 - Q1 GMC: Confirm the applicant's GMC.
 - **Q2 Student Teaching:** Answer "no" and note "Intern" in the comments section.
 - Q3 GPA: Answer what best makes sense for your IHE.
 - Q4 Program Completion and Recommendation: Answer "no" but confirm you recommend the applicant for an intern certification in the comments section.

Endorsement Protocol

- Tip: TIMS metrics do not align with endorsement affirmations.
- Action: PDE recommends the following protocol
 - Q1 GMC: Confirm the applicant's GMC.
 - **Q2 Practicum:** If the endorsement has a practicum requirement, answer "yes" if the applicant completed it. If the endorsement does not have a practicum requirement, mark "no" and note that in the comments.
 - Q3 GPA: Affirm whether the GPA provided is correct or not.
 - Q4 Program Completion and Recommendation: Affirm that the applicant completed the endorsement program and recommend them for the endorsement

TIMS Attestation Changes

Starting in Fall 2025, EPP certification officers will be required to check boxes in TIMS attesting to one of the following:

☐ The candidate completed at least 50% of their placement in Pennsylvania.

Check this box when:

- A candidate completes 100% of their 12-week placement in PA; or
- A candidate completes 50% of their 12-week placement in PA and the EPP has submitted the Out-Of-State/Out-Of-Country Placement Notification Form to PDE.
- ☐ The candidate did not complete at least 50% of their placement in Pennsylvania but had an approved waiver.

Check this box when:

 A candidate completes 100% of their 12-week placement at an entity outside of PA and the EPP has submitted – and PDE has approved – the Out-of-State/Out-Of-Country Waiver Form.



Affirmation Policy and Tips



Signature Requirements

- **Tip:** PDE cannot accept program affirmations/recommendations as valid before an applicant has completed their program.
- Note: Please do not submit program
 affirmations/recommendations before a program has been
 completed.




Response Time

- **Tip:** Log in to TIMS bi-weekly.
- **Tip:** PDE recommends responding to all program affirmations/recommendations as soon as feasible or within four weeks at the latest.
- Note: Applies even if you are not able to endorse the applicant.
- Note: Applications close if there has been no movement a year from the date the application was opened.



Response Time (cont.)





Confirming Program Requirements

- Tip: For applications that are not immediately submitted around the date of program completion, confirm that the completed program meets current requirements.
- Action: In the comments section, note that a review of the coursework completed determined that the applicant meets the requirements of the current approved program.
- PDE Protocol: Certification Services will reach out to Institutes of Higher Education (IHEs) via the Division of Professional Education and Teacher Quality (PETQ) to verify recommendations for programs completed five or more years ago if no note is present.



Dual Certification Programs

- Tip: Confirm program completion for absent dual certification areas in comments if not selected on TIMS.
- Example: If an applicant completed a dual program in PK-4 and Special Education PK-12 and only selected PK-4 on their application, a Certifying Officer should note the completion of the Special Education PK-12 program in the notes section of the application and PDE would find that acceptable.



Test Scores and Completing Affirmations

- Tip: Passing test scores do not need to be uploaded or matched in TIMS for a Certifying Officer to complete an affirmation/recommendation.
- Action: Complete affirmation/recommendation once official results are in hand.



Check Testing Requirements

- **Tip**: Verify current test requirements on the PDE website before referral via the Certification Test Score Requirements table.
- Policy: Assessments are periodically updated and replaced with a more current version. Results for assessments that have been discontinued or replaced will be considered if the assessment was taken at the time it was required or up to six months after the effective date of its replacement.
 - A candidate who registered for an assessment prior to the effective date of its replacement is not subject to the six-month window.
 - A candidate who takes the replaced assessment within the six-month window and fails will be given an additional six months. These allowances are subject to the availability of the replaced assessment.

Testing Examples

- Example 1: The current testing requirement for the Mathematics 7-12 certification is the (5165) test but Jane Doe would still qualify because she passed the (5161) test in 2015 which was the required test at the time for the Mathematics 7-12 certification.
- Example 2: The Social Studies content test (5081) was discontinued for a new test (5581) which became effective 09/01/2024. John Doe registered to take the Social Studies content test (5081) in January 2025 and received a passing score. John Doe's 5081 score would be accepted since it was completed within the six months of the 5581 becoming effective.



General Tips



GPA Scale

- **Tip:** The GPA scale allows applicants to use their teacher preparation program GPA to meet a qualifying score for their required certification tests. This is only usable with the completion of an educator preparation program.
- **Tip:** The GPA Qualifying Scores **may not** be used with:
 - Add-on applications
 - Intern applications
- Tip: TIMS will not apply the GPA Scale.
- Resource: See <u>CSPG 21</u> for more information.



Fundamental Subjects Test Requirement

- **Tip:** The Fundamental Subjects test is **not required** for initial dual certifications if one area is PK-4 or Grades 4-8. Also, it is not required following the issuance of an initial certification.
- Example: An applicant would still need to take the Fundamental Subjects test if their initial certification is a dual certification in English 7-12 and Special Education PK-12.

Testing Reminders for Your Students

- **Tip:** Remind students to verify personal information on tests.
- **Tip:** If a test is taken in PA, the score will automatically be sent to PDE. If a test is taken outside of PA, the applicant should use PDE's testing recipient code: 8033.
- Note: Inaccurate or missing social security numbers are one of the most common causes of application processing delays.



Military/Veterans Preference

- **Tip:** Preference is available to active-duty members, veterans, and spouses.
- Note: Preference grants the expediting of application processing and a sizable fee reduction.
- See website for documents required for verification:
 Veterans Preference (pa.gov)



Multiple Certification Areas

- Tip: Inform applicants they can apply for up to three certification areas per Instructional I application.
- Tip: Applicants can also apply for up to two areas per Instructional Add-On application.

TIMS Status

- Incomplete: Missing payment, applicant education information, etc.
- Submitted for IHE/LEA Verification: Waiting on IHE/LEA to confirm information.
- **Pending Additional Documentation:** Applicants were prompted to submit more information.
- Pending Test Score: Waiting on a passing test score.
- Awaiting Evaluation/Ready for Review: Waiting in queue to be assessed. Additional information might still be required upon review.
