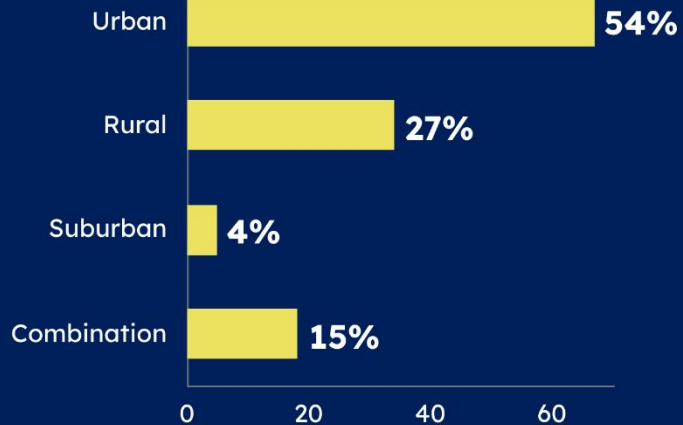

Program Geographic Context*



Students served in the after-school program represented approximately **1.4%** of PA's public school population.

21st CCLC Implementation



90% of subgrantees offered both STEM and literacy activities.



77% of subgrantees provided daily literacy-related activities.



72% of subgrantees provided daily math-related activities.



8,907 adult family members of participating students were served.

21st CCLC Outcomes & Impact

716 credits were recovered by 446 high school students.

89% of students completed the 2024-25 program year with a passing GPA.

48% of students who needed to improve their GPA accomplished this goal.

48% of students improved in at least one academic measure (state assessments, GPA, etc.).

18% of students in Grades 4-8 who needed to improve reading assessment scores accomplished this goal.

18% of students in Grades 4-8 who needed to improve math assessment scores accomplished this goal.
