RE: Withdrawal of Application to Open a Cyber Charter School

On November 19, 2025, the Division of Charter Schools (“the Division”) received written notice that Limitless Montessori Cyber Charter School (“Applicant”) wished to withdraw its application to open a cyber charter school in the Commonwealth, specifically requesting that it “be removed from further consideration”. The Division acknowledges receipt of Applicant’s notice to withdraw and as of November 19, 2025, the application is withdrawn. The Division will take no further action on the application, will not hold a public hearing, and will not render a written decision on the merits of the application.

You indicated you would like to convert this application into a charter school in the Twin Valley School District. The Division does not have the authority over the application process for brick and mortar charter schools, as that authority rests with school districts. See 24 P.S. § 17-1717-A(c).
