SAMPLE Montessori Schedule

8:30-9:00 Morning Circle

Students will work as a whole group. This time will encompass many things that are connected to other subject matter, but mostly language arts, science and social studies. We will open with calendar, speaking/listening and current events. Students will recognize the days of the week, months of the year and seasons. Students will be able to share information, ask questions, make announcements, and acknowledge their peers.

9:00-11:00 Montessori Centers

Students will work in small groups and individually. They will move freely between subjects at their own pace to achieve mastery of content in both subject areas and concepts being learned. Centers will include language arts, math, science and social studies. Teacher will pull students into small group sessions and also have one-to-one instruction during this time.

11:00-11:45 Specials (Health, Nutrition, Safety, Physical Education, Art, Music and Dramatic Play) (will vary by day)

Students will learn various safety rules and health practices, engage in physical activities such as yoga, strength training, gross motor activities, and strategies for play. Students will engage in the creation of their own are work using a variety of materials mediums, tools, etc. Students will also explore music, movement and drama as a group and individually using instruments, learning basic rhythm patterns, repeating patterns and using imagination and creativity to express themselves through drama.

11:45-12:45 Lunch & Recess

12:45-2:30 Montessori Centers

Students will again work in small groups or individually and will move freely between subjects at their own pace in order to achieve mastery of content in both subject areas and concepts being learned. Centers will include language arts, math, science and social studies. Students may venture into subject areas that they did not venture into during the morning centers. Teacher will pull students into small group session and also have one-to-one instruction during this time. Teacher will encourage students to venture into subject areas that they may not have ventured into earlier.
