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Introduction

The Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) requires Local Education Agencies (LEAs) to report the use of restraint with school-aged students in educational programs that have an Individualized Education Program (IEP). LEAs utilize the Restraint Information System Collection (RISC) data collection system to meet this requirement. RISC was developed by PDE, in conjunction with recommendations from the state Special Education Advisory Panel (SEAP). Annually, this report is presented to the Secretary of Education.

The Bureau of Special Education (BSE) closely monitors the use of positive behavior support and restraints by Local Educational Agencies (LEAs) across the Commonwealth. LEAs are required to comply with 22 Pa. Code § 14.133 (related to school entities) and 22 Pa. Code § 711.46 (related to charter schools and cyber charter schools). This includes reporting RISC data within 30 days of the restraint. 22 Pa. Code §§ 14.133(c)(5) and 711.46(c)(5). This also includes training of personnel in specific procedures, methods, and techniques of restraint. 22 Pa. Code §§ 14.133(f) and 711.46(f). The training of personnel should provide varied intervention and strategies needed to address problem behaviors. PDE asserts the use of restraints is considered a measure of last resort, only to be used after other less restrictive measures, including de-escalation techniques. PDE utilizes the Pennsylvania Training and Technical Assistance Network (PaTTAN) and the 29 Intermediate Units to provide ongoing training to LEAs in Positive Behavior Intervention and Support programs (PBIS) and other research-based practices and techniques to develop and maintain skills that enhance an educator's ability to prevent restraints.

In conjunction with training and technical assistance, BSE also closely monitors LEA compliance with positive behavior support during the Cyclical Monitoring for Continuous Improvement (CMCI) process and conducts ongoing restraint reviews as data reported in the RISC system throughout the school year. When necessary, BSE conducts further investigation with LEAs when the following instances occur: mechanical restraints (handcuff), electric shock intervention (taser), excessive restraints lasting longer than 60 minutes, multiple injuries occurring with student and/or staff, patterns of excessive holds of a specific student, patterns of excessive holds that have not decreased over time, excessive law enforcement interventions, high waiver count without reconvening the student's IEP team, serious injury warranting a BSE investigation, law enforcement intervention without reconvening the student's IEP team, restraint of a student with an IEP who committed an incident listed in section 1303-A(b)(4.1) or (4.2) of the Safe Schools Act (22 Pa. Code § 10.23), and staff not trained in de-escalation and restraint programs.
